LIKELY STORY broke in a bit of a tangle on the start, settled into a good rhythm three deep on the outside in the second trio of runners watching the lead three down the backside, was rein back getting to the rail at the half, saved ground on the turn patiently waiting for the cue to move looking for a path midway around the turn, moved in finding the three path at the top of the stretch, angled outside finally getting a clear lane six wide outside foes at the furlong pole and drove on by under only very little urging to edge away for the win in the final seventy yards. FLEURY had a good position under a snug hold on the rail watching the contesting duo early on, sat poised in the two path behind the embattled duo around the oval, closed in three wide at the top of the lane, split runners to get her head in front at the sixteenth pole but it wasn't enough late to fend off the winners late outside charge in deep stretch. KINZIE GIRL prompted the pace on the outside down the back straight, battled outside for the lead going head-to-head around the bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch, ran on willingly between rivals at the furlong pole, could not match strides with the top two in deep stretch but finished up well to be a clear third at the wire. TRACY ARM lacked early foot plus was climbing, seeing the field down the backside, started to figure things out midway on the turn closing the gap on the group by the quarter pole, angled to the four path for the stretch run, darted to the rail at the furlong pole reaching for more ground and had good late energy splitting horses in the two path in deep stretch to garner a minor placing in the end. BEAUTIFUL THINGS travelled in hand having a slim advantage on the inside down the backstretch, dueled on the rail throughout the turn, narrowly had the lead inside runners two wide turning for home, could not continue with the outside rivals bearing down at the furlong pole and wilted at the sixteenth pole. SUPERFLY CHICK was reluctant to load prior to the start, vied between rivals in the beginning, took back to track the contesting pair between foes at the half, inched up on the turn when scrubbed on for more at the quarter pole, angled out five wide for the stretch drive, then to the six path at the furlong pole but failed to fire in the late running. SAMARTINA (FR) kept a close eye on the lead twosome in the three path down the backside, ran evenly going three wide outside rivals on the turn, swung out widest in the six path straightening out for home, had little to give late and folded at the furlong marker.

HIGHLAND PEAK broke a step slow on the start, was hustled to get into the race co-trailing on the inside of another on the first turn, inched up on the fence down the backside by the half, was taken back, switching to the outside at the three-furlong pole, started to come with a strong rally four wide around foes at the quarter pole, was in full flight drifting inwards under a right handed crop at the furlong pole and stormed up the fence to powered past the leader in the final seventy yards for the stretch running win. DROGON travelled four wide near the rear on the first of two turns, advanced outside horses three deep down the backstretch at the half, had a good turn of foot three wide on the second turn closing in on the top two rivals, moved to the five path for the stretch run finding his best stride by the furlong pole but was outkicked by the surging winner in deep stretch. TREVALLY was content to sit outside off the flank of the pacesetter, continued to track outside never letting the leader get away down the backstretch, moved up to duel outside midway on the far turn, angled to the four path for the stretch run, fought on gamely outside to the wire and edged away for the win while only hand ridden in deep stretch. DIGITAL SECURITY had a slim lead on the fence early on, controlled the soft pace while shadowed on the

outside down the backstretch, continued up while hounded outside slowing the tempo down around the far turn, battled stubbornly under a well rated ride having more for the drive inside the winner two wide down the stretch and just missed at the finish line for the win. MAD WORLD was jostled between horses on the start, recouped to sit in the middle of the field on the rail through the first turn, dropped back slightly at the half, closed the gap when roused three wide at the midpoint of the final bend, moved out four wide gathering speed in upper stretch and was gaining steadily on the embattled pair in the final furlong but could not get to them in time, having to settled for the show award at the wire. GRAND WARRIOR (JPN) broke inwards on the start, had a good spot nestled on the rail behind the front pair, rated kindly appearing to be measuring the contesting top duo at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the three path in the hunt turning for home but evened out at the furlong pole to settle on the fringes in the end. HOT POTATO was unhurried seeing the field on the fence in the beginning, shared the rear inside another down the backside, started to make a move on the rail at the quarter pole, shifted two wide at the top off the stretch and finished up mildly on the rail in the final eighth of a mile but could not get into contention at the wire. SANHEDRIN settled between horses in the second flight, kept tabs on the engaged duo at the half, was scrubbed on for more keeping pace with the lead twosome while between runners through the far turn but lacked a finishing kick in the five path in the stretch running. TIZ THE POWER was forced out six wide by the inside rival on the first turn, improved to sit in mid-pack outside horses down the back straight, made a mild run four wide around horses at the three eighths marker, shifted five wide at the top of the lane but could not factor in the final furlong. FOUND MONEY travelled in the four path in the second flight early on, moved closer to watch the lead duo while three deep at the half, was holding his own going three wide outside foes on the far turn, swung out widest in the six path for the drive but no rally to offer in the late stages. TURBO CHARGED angled out five wide close to the back of the pack on the first turn, shared the rear outside another early in the backside, was asked at the three furlong pole but could not keep up to runners at the quarter marker. lost touch at the top of the stretch and walked off.

JAPONKA settled inside another rival in the third flight early on, was roused midway on the turn saving ground starting to make a move, angled out three wide leaving the quarter pole gathering more momentum, shifted to the five pat in with a chance at the top of the lane, stayed on the incorrect lead nevertheless kept coming on outside foes through the stretch and won going away in the final seventy yards. C C ATHENA was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field, save ground on the turn making little gain, scraped the paint coming with a good move turning for home, burst between runners in the two path at the furlong marker, drifted inwards under right handed encouragement by the sixteenth pole and had one final surge in deep stretch, just missing the nod for the runners up share inside at the finish line. WUNHAPPY WABBIT had a stalking role close to the back of the pack, improved smartly under a hold between foes at the seven sixteenths pole, made a big three wide swooping move around the bend to open up on the field at the top of the stretch, did not switch leads to the wire and was caught by runners when stalling in the final seventy yards. DIXIE DOLL veered in on the break, became headstrong rushing up leaving the chute having to be checked briefly entering the backstretch, was shuffled back a few positions at the half, made no progression two wide through the turn and finished up with good late energy in the five path outside horses in deep stretch. LORRAINE'S BEAUTY was under a snug hold watching the pacesetter down the backstretch, inched up inside rivals midway on the turn, shifted out off the tiring early leader three wide at the quarter pole, stayed on the incorrect lead in the mix three wide in mid-stretch, could not find more late and faded in deep stretch. GOLDEN GOOSE was pushed out by the inside runner on the break, stalked three deep outside foes near the rear down the back straight, took the overland route four wide making little headway around the turn and could only manage to pass tired runners in the six path down the lane. CLEAR POSITION travelled outside another in the third tier down the back straight, was nudged on three wide on the turn making little movement, angled to the six path for the drive to the wire but failed to fire in the final furlong. MYHUSBANDSAGENIUS was loose up top leaving the chute, continued to roll along unchallenged at the half, had a shrinking advantage midway on the turn, offered no resistance surrendering the lead by the quarter pole, began to shorten stride on the fence in upper stretch tiring to hold for a small share, had to be steadied in tight on the rail coming to sixteenth pole and tired in deep stretch. SOCIALLY INTACT tracked the pacesetter on the outside early on, could not keep up on the turn regressing between horses at the five sixteenths marker, had to be checked losing its path three wide leaving the quarter pole and emptied out in the five path at the top of the stretch. PLAYMEA TUNE had a stalking trip between runners in the two path along the back straight, moved up getting better forward position by the half, was poised on the turn ready to make a move, angled out five wide having a quick turn of foot at the top of the stretch, was full of run closing in at the furlong marker and edged away from a stubborn frontrunner in deep stretch outside for the win. SOUPED UP poked his head in front having runners on either side down the backstretch, dueled inside a pesky speed rival throughout the turn maintaining a slim advantage, spurted clear hugging the rail straightening out for the drive, kept on running gamely on the fence down the lane but could not fend off the winner late and gave way grudgingly in the final seventy yards. RUNNIN' ROCKET pressed the pace on the rail in the beginning, was reined back on the fence watching the engaged pair at the half, drafted behind the lead pair on the turn waiting for the cue to go, moved out three wide posing a threat in upper stretch, could not quicken with the lead duo by the eighth pole stalling somewhat and ran on well enough to be a clear third at the finish line. PIPER'S FACTOR prompted the pace on the outside early on, continued to be a thorn in the leaders side battling outside around the turn, gave way in the four path dueling up top in upper stretch and finished up evenly in the final eighth of a mile to last for the minor award in the end. I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) settled at the rear with the field quite compact down the backside, shifted outside three wide at the three furlong pole still seeing the field around the bend, shifted inwards to the rail in mid-stretch and came with a mild late run inside horses dueling for a minor share at the wire. TWIN CITY travelled in midfield going three deep outside of a couple of runners down the backside, kept pace still outside going three wide around the turn, swung out widest in the six-path turning for home but lacked a finishing kick in the stretch drive.

EL KABONG forced the pace outside, moved clear by the three-quarters shifting in, weakened. PERFECT CRIME was caught four wide on the first turn, pulled toward the front keenly to press up the backstretch, dropped back and came up empty.

NOBALS had a nice set up on the rail watching the contesting pair, inched up still keeping a close eye on the embattled duo in midturn, shifted out off the leaders at the quarter pole three wide coming with a rally, had aim four wide straightening out for home, seized control under a well-timed move getting clear at the sixteenth pole and just held on from the late closing outside rivals at the finish line. LUCKY SCORE had his customary spot seeing the field in the early stages finding his stride down the backstretch, started to get into gear midway on the turn closing the gap, swung out widest in the six path having clear run in full flight, stormed home in the five path in the final furlong outside runners, drifted in driving to the finish line in deep stretch under right handed encouragement and got for the runners up share while just missing with the late surge for the victory as well. SOCIETY'S THUNDER settled in mid-division while in the three path along the backside, moved in closer to be on outside the eventual winner in the second flight midpoint of the turn, shifted out five wide for the stretch run gathering speed, came with a good late charge between horses in the four path in the thick of it all with a furlong remaining, was squeezed in tight quarters driving to the wire late and steadied in the final few jumps before the wire settling for a minor share in a blanket finish for the top four positions. WESTERN WHIRL bobbled slightly on the start, quickly recovered to have a slim lead inside down the back straight, maintained a narrow advantage on the rail with a pesky speed rival dueling outside on the bend, still kept his head in front skimming the fence turning for home, stubbornly battled inside rivals down the lane but could not find more in the late running and wilted by the sixteenth pole. RELOAD'S RASCAL moved well hounding the pacesetter outside down the backstretch, took even closer order forcing the issue outside throwing it down under a brisk tempo around the turn, determinedly bid between horses in the two path up top at the top of the lane, fought on until the eighth pole and folded in the late running. LOGISTICS travelled very comfortably in hand pressing the pace inside down the backstretch, edged away for the lead at the three-furlong pole on the rail, rolled along up front around the turn, still was in command in the two path in mid-stretch with outside rivals closing in, found more under a vigorous ride in the final furlong and held safe for the front end win. GALLEY HEAD watched the lead pair while inside another along the backside, rallied on the rail moving in on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out three wide between rivals making a bid straightening out for the drive, dug in determinedly chasing the winner through the lane but could not get by in the final furlong. VOICE FROM ABOVE settled between horses in the middle of the pack, moved in sharply four wide around challengers at the quarter pole, angled out to the five path reaching for more ground at the head of the lane and continued to be full of run in the final furlong to get up on the outside right at the wire for the third place award. SILENT SKY travelled on the fence in midfield, rode the rail inching up throughout the turn, took closer order inside runners to be in with a chance in the two path turning for home, was no match for the lead duo who had it to themselves in the final furlong and settled for a minor share in the end just missing out holding on for the battle of the show money inside in deep stretch. HOLIDAY WITH AMY had runners on either side while in mid-division with a half mile still to run, narrowed the margin on the fence midpoint of the turn, shifted out to be four wide at the quarter pole mounting a rally, angled to the six path for the stretch run and ran on willingly in the final furlong passing rivals outside. HAPPY VALENTINE had an outside tracking position early on, closed in three wide outside horses in midturn to be in the hunt in the four path outside the lead duo at the top of the stretch, stalled, unable to keep up to the front duo by the furlong pole and faded in deep stretch losing positions late. HAY HAY PAULA shared the rear outside another at the half, angled out three wide beginning to lengthen stride midway on the turn, started to pick up the bit five wide at the top of the lane and had late interest passing runners in the final eighth of a mile. VERY SAVVY travelled three deep in mid-division by the half, regressed going in the wrong direction outside runners midway around the turn, was floated out by the inside rivals to be seven wide at the top of the stretch and showed little in the drive to the finish line. CLARAYOUTHEBEST co-trailed on the inside with a half mile remaining, saved ground but made little impact running around the oval and failed to menace in the three path in the stretch drive. MY CASH FACTOR had a stalking role only ahead of a couple of runners down the back straight, offered little progression through the bend, was passed on either side to be at the rear four wide at the top of the stretch and could not factor in the later stages. BRAVO KATE had a head in front in the beginning, started to give way relinquishing the front end outside at the three eighths marker, steadily retreated between horses at the quarter pole and emptied out two wide in upper stretch.
