## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BOSSY CANDY tracked from inside, took closer order up the backstretch, moved out nearing the quarter pole, came into upper stretch four wide with aim, was put to urging, took a narrow lead in mid-stretch, edged away late. SOUPER DIVA was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail shadowed by outside foes, moved clear of those runners passing the seven-sixteenths, was challenged at the top of the stretch, fought on gamely inside the winner in mid-stretch but was no match while clearly second best. MATHEMATICAL pursued from outside, went four to five wide on the turn, lugged in a bit in the stretch, was no match for the top pair but clear of the rest. PAGEANT QUEEN settled into stride off the pace and just off the inside, was lightly brushed and in a hair tight in the early going, saved ground on the rail through the turn advancing inside rivals, kept on evenly. ZABARTA broke outwardly, lacked early

speed racing outside at the back, swung eight wide turning for home and passed some foes. SOUPER SPORTY chased three to four wide, weakened. SPLASH OF BOURBON was bumped at the start, moved forward between foes brushing a rival in the process, briefly pressed the leader two to three wide, continued to chase then dropped back. SIPPING HISTORY stumbled, losing the irons and bumping a rival at the start, was never a threat.
