PERFECT CRIME settled off the pace near the back, steadily advanced outside foes on the turn five to six wide, continued to gain in the stretch, got up late. BLANCO was encouraged forward between foes taking the lead after the opening furlong, moved clear and shifted in a bit to set the pace just off the rail, shook clear of pursuer past the three-eighths, weakened noticeably in the stretch while still well clear and was caught late. CHAMBERS bumped a rival lightly at the start, advanced inside late up the backstretch, moved out near the quarter pole and was put to urging with aim on the leader, kept on evenly in

the stretch. PROCTOR PHANTOM stalked from outside mid-division, raced four to five wide through the turn, kept grinding away but was too little too late. JOURNEYMAN settled well back inside foes, saved ground on the turn, rallied up the rail in the stretch and was gaining late. HANLAN was forwardly-placed stalking outside, went three to four wide, weakened. GILT EDGE was encouraged forward, tracked the leader up the backstretch just off the rail, steadied when in tight in deep stretch. ITSASTORMYMONDAY tucked in a bit up the backstretch racing between foes off the pace, went three wide on the turn, faced traffic through the stretch and was never asked in earnest. POSEIDON STEEL was lightly bumped at the start, raced inside at the back and failed to menace. MO' SPRESSO chased the leaders outside a foe in the third group, was under a ride by the five-sixteenths but dropped back between runners, faded.
