NACHO BAR bumped with an outer foe at the start, set the pace inside, was cued while off the rail in the two path passing the quarter, and kicked away while being ridden out down the lane to be much the best. SMACKDOWN pressed the winning inner pacesetter in the two path, was coaxed along in the three path around the turn, bid passing the quarter, got repelled by the winner at the top of the stretch, but ran on to clearly hold place. THE KWEEN'S KING stalked in the three path, came under a ride entering the turn, floated out to the five path in upper stretch, made no closing bid, but held show. SWEET DEVOTION tracked behind the leading duo in the two path, was pushed along around the turn, but faded in the stretch. LORD CREW bumped with the inner foe at the start, rated inside. SUPERHERO chased outside of rivals, was ridden in the four path around the turn, but did not threaten. DAWN STRATEGY was slow into stride and trailed, merged into the two path while under a drive entering the turn, but failed to menace. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
