BUSINESS AS USUAL bumped mildly with the horse to his outside at the start, recovered to lead the way from the rail up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and drew off in the lane. SUPRISING CODE chased the leader on the outside early, navigated the bend from the two path and was no match for the winner in the stretch but kept on to the finish from there. ASPIRATIONAL raced off the pace on the inside through the opening quarter, came around the turn in the three path and improved position in the stretch. CALLITFATELUCKARMA stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the bend in the four path and was outkicked in the lane. MORNING HOLIDAY raced in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the turn and showed no kick. RAINBOW SMILES raced off the pace on the outside through the early going, came around the turn in the six path and was never a threat. AMASS MONEY tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the two path and faded from there. WILD GOLD RUSH raced off the pace between horses through the opening stages, came around the turn in the four path and was empty in the lane. FRESNO CHILE bumped lightly with the horse to his inside leaving the gate, settled in the middle of the pack on the rail for the run up the backstretch, dropped back while saving ground around the bend and tired further in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
