BATTLE PASS POSSE vied for the early lead in the two path, opted to press the pace through the turn, took charge at the three sixteenths and kicked clear. CODE MANDALORE tracked the pace between rivals, tipped out three wide at the top of the stretch, improved for the place award but did not switch leads, no match for the winner. TIGERSAURUS REX moved up to vie for command along the inside, claimed a narrow lead through the turn, gave way to the winner at the three sixteenths, weakened to third down the stretch. STOOPS TORNADO settled back to be the early trailer, began to make improvements along the outside of the pack starting at the quarter. THE KWEEN'S KING vied for the early lead, backed off to track the pace four wide at the half, began closing some ground through the turn but flattened out upon entering the stretch. DERBY DAY tracked the pace from the inside, backed off through the turn to trail just after the quarter, passed retreating foe in the stretch. DOUBLE RAP vied for the early lead three wide, backed off at the half to shadow the pace through the turn, faded down the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
