GIRLS KNICKS NOW set a clear pace in the two path, waited confidently around the turn, floated out to the four path while coming under a ride at the top of the lane, kicked away while on the left lead, and was wrapped up around the sixteenth. OH MY VRON prompted the early pace from the four path but lost ground passing the half, was ridden in the two path around the turn, could not keep up with the winner down the stretch, but clearly held place. IRISH WIT had an awkward start, raced off the pace in the three path, was ridden in the five path around the turn, swung out to the seven path at the top of the lane, and finished evenly outside of foes while on the left lead for show. BOUGIE LIKE chased outside of foes from the six path, angled to the four path entering the turn, was ridden around the turn, but did not factor from the five path in the stretch. CASHOUT CAROL stalked between rivals from the five path early, was driven in the three path around the turn, but gave way in the stretch. ROBIN RED trailed along the rail throughout. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
