CODE ELEVEN raced in the three path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the inside for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the four path coming around the turn and gained ground late to get up for the win. PONTOTOC raced in the four path early, continued up the backstretch off the pace on the inside, began a bid from the three path nearing the three eighths pole and gained ground late. GOSPEL DON raced in the two path around the first bend, tracked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, challenged from the three path coming around the second bend, dueled in the stretch and was caught late. FLAT BE JUDGED saved ground around the first turn, chased the leader on the inside up the backstretch, navigated the far turn from the two path an weakened in the lane. KALUKI led the way while saving ground through the opening half mile, dueled from the rail around the second turn and faded in the stretch. DR J Y. G raced in the three path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, swung out to the four path coming around the far turn and made no bid. GOSPEL UP raced in the four and five path around the first turn, settled off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, pulled up headed into the far turn and left the track in an equine ambulance.
