JANES GIRLS settled at the back while sizing up the pace situation, was always within range given the slow pace, being set up front, kept to the outside up he backstretch, steadily advanced into the turn, then went after the leaders leaving the five-sixteenths marker, became the outside horse in ta three-way battle to the wire, and got the favorable head bob at the line. GRACE THE KINGDOM contested the early pace from the inside in a three-way battle while under some restraint, was let loose mid-way through the turn, took the lead into the stretch battled gamely as a pair of rivals game up on both sides to challenge, then came up on the short end of the photo at the wire in a good effort. FLAT OUT FANCY tucked in behind the pacesetting trio under a rating hold, was boxed in through the last turn, got clear in the stretch and made strong bid up the rail but came up short in a blanket finish. SABRES vied three-wide in the early pace mix, was close up to to deep stretch, then outkicked in the last furlong. MISKELLIEANNE was unable to get into the early pace mix despite coaxing from the rider out of the gate, settled back and was unable to threaten. SWEET AUNT ROSIE raced up on the early pace between rivals through the first half, weakened before the quarter pole, then had nothing left for the stretch run.
