SHARP LORENZO settled just off the pace, came four-wide into the stretch, hooked in with BUCKIN AGAIN in the late stages, got a very narrow advantage in the final yards and just held on. BUCKIN AGAIN chased the two pacesetters into the turn, bid three-wide approaching the stretch, had trouble with the lead change in upper stretch, dueled gamely with SHARP LORENZO to the wire, and just missed. MANNY'S KAT raced in the middle of the pack and about four-wide up the backstretch, lost some position entering the turn, launched a sustained bid for the three-furlong pole, came six-wide into the stretch and finished up well to gain third. STOMPING HOTROD was outpaced from the break, steadily advanced up the backstretch, and finished up well, advancing up the rail. DA CHIEF raced in mid-pack six-wide early, advanced to the leaders late on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch with every chance, then flattened out in the final furlong. FAVORITE OUTLAW ducked in at the break, bumped NOISE COMPLAINT, then rushed up to take the early lead, shrugged

off all challengers on the turn, came into the stretch with a clear lead, then weakened inside the last sixteenth. NOISE COMPLAINT broke awkwardly then lost the path at the start, started behind the field, chased from the rear, then ran on some in the late stages. MEGA SHACK broke best, then ceded the lead to FAVORITE OUTLAW, remained in a stalking position to the outside, came under a ride at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. VICENTE'S SHADOW trailed the field from the start, came four-wide into the stretch and passed a couple of tired foes late. AWESOME OUTLAW chased in the middle of the pack up the backstretch, then faded on the turn. CALL OF HONOR steadily dropped back after a level start, and was never involved while saving ground throughout.
