CALEB'S FINEST was close up on the pace while tracking the leaders from four wide down the backstretch then moved up on the final turn to engage the leader near the quarter pole then she drove past the leader and drew off. MORNING HOLIDAY raced off the pace on the inside to the top of the stretch where she tipped out to two wide for a late run but was no match for the winner and proved second best. GOSPEL FABULOUS cut the corner to take a clear lead on the first turn to the half mile marker then rivals moved up to challenge her on the final turn and was collared at the top of the stretch and she tired. SKY ECHO was allowed to settle at the back trailing the field by many lengths to the quarter pole where she made a mild belated bid to pass a tired one. CLOUD ANGEL sped away from the gate then stalked the pace from three wide to the half mile marker before giving way.
