CLASSY EMPIRE rated kindly on the front end down the backside, stifled outside bidder into the lane, kicked away driving through the final sixteenth. MOR LANA SPIRIT broke alertly, stalked the pace two wide down the backside, given the queue leaving the three eighths marker, tested the stubborn leader into the lane, no match leaving the sixteenth post, chased on well late, second best. QUARTERLY REPORT bumped at the start, relaxed off the pace down the backside, cut the corner into the lane, vigorous inside rally through the final sixteenth, up in time for the show money. SOUL SACRIFICE saved ground around the first turn, found a clean pocket just off the top pair around the far turn, tipped out four wide through the lane, improved placing very late. RED MOUNTAIN saved ground well off the pace, put to task between runners in upper stretch, gaining ground inside the sixteenth marker, stalled out late. STORMS LAST brushed bumped back at the start, trailer down the backside, roused off the pace into the lane, running on the wrong lead, wandered through the lane, weakened to the wire.
