COLD FACT hustled up to grab the lead before the half-mile pole, maintained a length advantage on the field through the turn, responded to strong handling and drew clear in upper stretch, and was geared down near the finish. CAJUN STOOPS broke best but was overtaken before the half, remained in a close-up tracking position four-wide through the turn, and finished up well. WASHITA VALLEY off a step slow, then hustled up five wide through the early running, continued on three-wide through the stretch, and finished well to share the second prize. YOUTGOTTHISJR settled off the pace to begin, moved over to the inside heading into the turn, pressed for the lead approaching the three-furlong pole, was unable to threaten for the win but stayed on in the stretch. MORTIFY was the early trailer but not far behind through the early stages, came out for wide into the stretch, finished willingly, but was unable to make a late impact. K Q SPIRIT rushed up after the start to press the early pace, remained prominent to the quarter pole, then went evenly in the stretch and was unable to improve. CHIEF CHITTOZ was briefly up with the pack and started to drop back, heading into the turn and did not offer a rally.
