BILLIE BABY outpaced near the back early, circled the field four-wide, caught the leading pair before the furlong marker, then went clear in the late stages to prevail. AN AWESOME LEGACY dueled inside a rival to the turn, yielded midway through the turn, but kept to task and came back on, and just held on for second to a fast closing rival. PALMILLA'S BET settled well off the pace, saved ground, and rallied up the rail to just miss second. PRAIRIE BRAT bumped lightly with the outside rival after the start, dueled outside a rival to the turn, gained the upper hand leaving the three-furlong pole, had some trouble with the lead change in the stretch, and faltered late. CALL DARLA dropped back to last after a good start, raced three-wide and ran on some late to improve. GIRLS KNICKS NOW was initially up on the early pace, backed off before the half, settled in mid-pack, and did not have a late response. BOUGIE LIKE raced three-wide throughout, and lacked a rally. MIRAGE CODE was one-paced and outfinished in the stretch.
