BEE A QUEEN dropped back early on to race mid pack, two deep near the quarter pole, shifted out six wide through the drive and edged up under all out pressure. BELLE BLAZE void of early speed, moved up five wide from the outside through the far turn and rallied gamely to the wire. RAILEY JEAN vied for the early lead along the inside and gave way grudgingly late. NORMA JEAN BLING vied three deep between rivals and weakened through the drive. WOMAN'S INTUITION prompt the early pace from the outside of rivals and weakened the final eighth of a mile. COWGIRLSLIKEBLING raced three to four wide around the far turn and had no response. GIRLS A LEGACY hopped at the start, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. PRESLEYS VOLLEY urged along between rivals and was done early.
