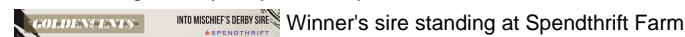

BIG MUCKITY stalked the pace, raced near the inside past the quarter pole, angled out through the upper lane and finished well to edge up under strong handling. BIG KITTY tracked the top pair three deep, asked four wide near the quarter pole, led near the sixteenth pole and missed in a game effort. MI SATURDAY dueled along the inside and gave way to the top pair grudgingly late. PAYNT BALL raced near the back early on, made a good rail bid in the lane and was closing in. SALT CREEK KID dropped back to race mid pack early, raced four wide near the quarter pole, six wide into the upper stretch and was even with no late bid. OUR CORNERSTONE raced two to three wide and had no response. GUAPO dueled two deep from the outside of rival and faded. SEND THE BOSS was off slowly, saved ground and never threatened. TZEDAKAH raced four to five wide into the upper stretch and failed to sustain a bid.
