FINE TUNED hopped slightly at the start, settled to the turn, angled four wide to upper stretch, made a sustained rally while widest through the lane, surged late, up in time. SMACKDOWN pressed the early pace three wide, vied for the lead two wide into the stretch, dueled EVEN TERMS into the final sixteenth, had a narrow lead into deep stretch then was nailed on the wire for the win, while just holding for second. EVEN TERMS pressed the early pace two wide and between foes, dueled inside of SMACKDOWN into upper stretch, was game while battling that rival into the final sixteenth, was outkicked in deep stretch but held for third. PEA EYE sent to dispute the early pace from the inside, got caught in tight nearing the quarter pole, angled out then re-bid three wide into the stretch, was gaining late but could not reel in the leaders in deep stretch. NJUSTLIKETHAT vied for the early lead three deep and between foes, took back into the turn, chased from the inside into upper stretch, was gaining in the final sixteenth but ran into traffic late and could not offer a further response. TITLE TALK away in good order, settled to the turn, coaxed three wide to upper stretch, no final bid. GOSPEL WAR CRY broke out at the start then was off slowly, settled while saving ground to the turn, kept an inside path to the stretch and did not factor late. E D'ORO hopped then broke out at the start and was off slowly, coaxed three to four wide along the turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch, did not threaten late.
