AN AWESOME LEGACY vied for the early lead, engaged with PRAIRIE BRAT and dueled for pace duties inside of that rival heading to the turn, disputed the pace to the quarter marker then lost the lead into upper stretch, came again into the lane, took command at the furlong grounds and kicked clear late while in hand. PRAIRIE BRAT showed early speed and disputed the early pace outside of AN AWESOME LEGACY, dueled that one to the quarter marker then took command to upper stretch, drifted out and lost the lead nearing the furlong grounds, chased the winner to deep stretch and was a clear second. BEE BLUFF crowded a bit at the start, climbed while trailing in the early going, was last into the turn, made a sustained bid along the rail into the stretch, could not impact the top pair late but held safely for third. BOUGIE LIKE away from the gate a step slowly, settled while saving ground into the turn, angled two then three wide to upper stretch, no late rally and outkicked for third. STAIRSTEP TOHEAVEN tracked the dueling early leaders from the second flight, well placed while three wide to the quarter pole, lacked the needed response to mid-stretch and weakened late. BEVERLY DINER settled off of the early pace, coaxed two wide to the quarter pole, steered to three path to upper stretch, was widest to the furlong marker and did not factor late.
