MIGHTY MESSAGE broke alertly, ceded the early lead then stalked the pace three wide into the turn, moved up to vie for the lead nearing the quarter marker, dug in and led to mid-stretch, met the bid of SPEIGHT AND MALICE into the final sixteenth and just held for the win. SPEIGHT AND MALICE hustled from the start, vied for the early lead then pressed the pace from the inside heading into the turn, battled from the rail into upper stretch, fought gamely while gaining ground on MIGHTY MESSAGE into the final furlong, was denied for the win and held safe for second. BEAU DAY sent to dispute the early pace, vied between runners and took a narrow lead along the backstretch, contested the pace into the turn, lost ground to upper stretch then angled out at the furlong marker, battled to the final sixteenth but could not reel in the top pair late and held for third. DA CHIEF rated just off of the early pace, tracked three wide to the quarter marker, angled four wide to upper stretch and was set down for the drive, battled to deep stretch but could not muster the needed late response and missed for third. WHIP allowed to settle, trailed into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and did not threaten in the late stages. GOLD MEMBER hopped then was crowded at the start and was off slowly, rushed up early on and tracked the pace from the second flight heading to the turn, fanned four to five wide to upper stretch, could not keep pace to the furlong pole and weakened in the drive.
