SEARČHIN SAFARI stalked from off the inside part of the course four deep into the turn, moved closer four to five wide, bid in mid-stretch, took a narrow lead that lasted till the wire and was just outfinished. WESTCOAST BREEZE shifted in, was mid-division into the turn, edged closer two to three wide, rallied inside runners in the stretch steadily gaining but just missed. ISAIDWHATISAID shifted in, raced two wide through the turn, kept on late to improve. NOISE COMPLAINT stalked from between runners racing five to seven wide throughout, kept on. FORTY STRANGERS stalked from outside six to eight wide and needed more. PRINCE OF EARL was outpaced early racing wide, came into the stretch six deep and ran on with mild late interest. LUCKY MCCOY settled off the pace, moved out from three to five wide on the turn, was never near enough to threaten. MAJESTIC

CRAKEN broke a step slowly, switched out off the inside heading up the backstretch, went three wide on the turn advancing between foes, lacked a late effort. DOCS DUTY broke in the air, was outpaced early, swung out for the drive, was not a threat. DEROY was mid-pack inside saving ground through the turn, weakened.
