SEATTLE SURF dueled outside of VOICES OF AUTISM from the start, got the better of that rival in upper stretch, and continued clear to the finish. VOICES OF AUTISM dueled inside of SEATTLE SURF, weakened in upper stretch but kept on to save the place. MALIBU SANGRIA raced between horses in the tracking group, lacked a winning late kick but stayed on well to claim the minor award. LEVI GONE WILD raced in the middle of the field and held position through the stretch. MISSIONARY MARY raced three-wide in the second flight, then flattened out in the lane. MR. THIRSTY tracked the dueling leaders to the stretch, but lacked a late bid. CRONE ZONE was outpaced early on and did not produce a late bid. TRES TENADORES broke well, dropped back to last, moved out to the five-path at the top of the stretch, but did not offer a rally. DIABLOS MOON was off slowly, trailed early and lacked a finish.
