CLUE raced in the four path around the first turn, pressed the pace on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the far turn in the two path and kicked clear in the lane. VALENTINO WHO saved ground at the back of the pack through the opening half mile, swung out to the five path coming around the far turn, began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late. INDY'S SONG raced in the three path around the first turn, dueled between horses up the backstretch, navigated the second bend from the three path and chased on to the finish. DADDY WHAT IF raced in the three path early, trailed the field up the backstretch, began a bid from the five path coming around the far turn and improved position from there. ARCH CITY raced in the five path around the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the far bend in the three path and weakened in the lane. COMING ABSTRACTION raced in the four path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the far turn still in the four path and was outkicked in the stretch. MAXIMUM BULL raced in the two path early, continued up the backstretch in the middle of the pack on the inside, came around the second turn still in the two path and was empty in the lane. GRIFTER raced off the pace in the three path around the first turn and up the backstretch, swung out to the six path coming around the far turn and made no bid. KING BRYCE raced in the two path early, dueled on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the second turn and tired in the stretch.
