EXIT STRATEGY bobbled leaving the gate, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, came around the turn in the three path, began a big entering the stretch and gained ground late to get up for the win. PRIVATE EQUITY dueled on the outside through the opening quarter, continued to battle from the two path around the bend and dug in to wire to narrowly miss. M L'S SPORTSCASTER bumped mildly with the horse to his inside at the start, recovered to chase the leaders up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the three path and dueled in late stretch but was caught late. SUNSHINE LUTE dueled on the inside up the backstretch, continued to battle while saving ground around the turn and weakened in the final furlong. SHINY SHORES raced off the pace on the outside early, came around the turn in the four path and showed no kick. SAPELLO GUSTO raced in the middle of the pack up the backstretch, continued around the bend in the four path and made no bid. MASINO bumped with the horse to his outside leaving the gate, dropped back to trail well behind the field up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two and three path and made no bid. SR ANDREW raced at the back of the pack through the opening stages, saved ground around the turn and was empty in the lane.
