TRUMP DANCE tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the four path and gained ground late to get up for the win in the final jump. TEXAS TECH LEGS led the way on the inside through the opening quarter, came around the bend in the two path, kicked clear in upper stretch and was caught in the final strides. ALL MARKED UP chased the leader on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the three path and kept on to the wire. DESERT HOPE veered out leaving the gate, raced at the back of the pack early, came around the bend in the four path and improved position in the lane. MY KENTUCKY CHROME raced off the pace up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the turn and made up some ground in the stretch while never truly threatenng. WICKED WHISKEY bumped with the horse to his inside leaving the gate, trailed the field up the backstretch, continued around the bend in the three path and never threatened. ADELYN'S DREAM raced in the middle of the pack between horses through the opening stages, navigated the bend from the two path and faded in the lane. BLUES MONEY raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and tired in the stretch. RIGGY TEA bumped with the horse to his outside at the start, settled in the middle of the pack between horses for the run up the backstretch, swung out to the seven path coming around the bend and was empty in the lane.
