BUY LOCAL tracked just off the pace racing four-wide, was fanned five-wide in a bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, loomed a danger, then hung and flattened out in the final yards. COUNTRY CLUB SPORT dueled inside of a rival, then stopped in upper stretch.
