BAROSSA tracked comfortably in the second position from the outset, ranged up approaching the quarter pole to challenge ATTILA THE DUN for the lead, met some resistance but put away that rival in upper stretch, then drew away late while being geared down in the late stages. WINNING BIG settled mid-pack three-wide, started a forward bid going into the far turn, was in a stiff drive before the quarter pole, and kept on to win the battle for the place. KIRBY DERBY raced mid-pack through the first half-mile, made up some ground late under a drive to gain the third spot. ATTILA THE DUN made the lead before the first turn, led the way through moderate fractions to the far turn, dug in when challenged by BAROSSA on the far turn, battled to mid-stretch, and tired. WHERES BRAYDEN settled mid-pack four-wide early, then advanced through the turn, bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, chased WHEREDOESTHECASHGO determinedly through the stretch, and got up in the last jumps. WHEREDOESTHECASHGO broke sharply and cleared the field early, got a bit of a breather on the turn, then had something left when challenged by WHERE'S BRAYDEN in the stretch, was all out to hold on in the final yards, but was unable to hold off the stablemate in the last jumps. PLAYING FIELD settled five-wide down the backstretch in the middle of the field, continued that path through the turn and into the stretch, and finished up with some late interest to gain the third spot. EFFORT N RESULTS advanced under a ride after a tardy start, raced close up on the rail, had every chance at the top of the stretch but could not find a winning kick. MAJORWAYHOME tracked three-to-four wide down the backstretch, backed off a bit going into the turn, then tipped out to the four path in the stretch, and rallied mildly but was not a serious threat. RYDERS UP broke with the pack but dropped off the pace as the field went into the turn, tried to come back under heavy urging in the stretch, but did not respond. Z MARKS THE SPOT broke in the air and spotted the field a head start, chased from far back, and could not make an impact. HOT CHARLIE chased WHEREDOESTHECASHGO through the early stages, dropped out under a drive late on the turn, then had little left for the stretch run.
