TACTICAL TRACKSTAR coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths marker, tipped five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, edged clear to the finish kept to task. MAGNI chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch, came under coaxing tucked to the two path inside the half mile pole, angled six wide into upper stretch and ran on to secure the place honors. FISCAL DRAG coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. MAJESTIC ARC struck the near side stall at the start, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch, offered no kick. COOL HAND RICH coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand three then two wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught just outside the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. TAPWRITS TEMPER a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased six then five wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled out widest, eight to nine wide at the head of the stretch, weakened.

BOURBON DAY was hustled from the gate then coaxed along off the pace, passed the nine-sixteenths pole under stronger urging, chased in the two path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under the crop, gained to make a bid inside of the leading duo at the furlong marker, took the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under steady handling. LE GRIS was hustled from the gate, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader with company also to his outside, vied in the three path while drawing even on the turn, dueled with CRUSHED IT until inside the furlong marker then proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. CRUSHED IT stalked the pace on the outside, inched closer in the four path on the turn, was roused late on that bend, turned into upper stretch on even terms for the lead, dueled with the runner-up until inside the furlong marker and weakened but was clear for the show. WYNSTOCK climbed behind horses entering the main-track, settled at the rear, came under a strong hand-ride near the nine-sixteenths pole, rounded the turn in the three path, was put to the crop inside the three-eighths pole, spun into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. FILM STAR broke in and was last away then was hustled, moved up to show the way inside of foes, was asked in the two path on the turn, dropped to the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and faded.

HEAVENLY LIGHT pressed the pace five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn at times noses apart for command, got set down spinning four wide into upper stretch, seized command with three-sixteenths to go and edged away under a left handed crop shying out three paths from the eighth pole to the sixteenth marker before being corrected under a right handed crop while safe to the finish. SCARLET'S DREAM hustled from the gate, vied briefly to the five and a half furlong marker before chasing just off the inside down the backstretch and through the turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, went six wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. CARA'S DREAMWEAVER chased three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled out seven wide at the top of the stretch, offered up a mild kick. BLENHEIM BABY chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the turn getting ridden along with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled in to corner just off the inside into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. SAUCY SIX chased four then two wide under urging from the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up late foot but was outkicked to the wire. CHOCOLATECHOCOLATE hustled from the gate, vied briefly with a pair of rivals before emerging in concert with HEAVENLY LIGHT five and a half furlongs from home, showed the way three then two wide under pressure from that rival to the outside, got coaxed along at the three-eighths pole, swung three wide into upper stretch and had the rider lose the handle on his crop to the left side at the quarter pole, got headed for command at the three-sixteenths and tired through to the finish.

MANHATTAN CHROME went to the front then set the pace under pressure, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the turn, lost the advantage outside the quarter-pole, fought on well in the stretch, regained the lead into the final furlong and gamely prevailed under steady urging. RICHIES LOVE had his saddle adjusted behind the gate, was well placed just off the pace, saved ground while asked on the far turn, was taken in hand off heels late on that bend, steadied briefly behind horses in upper stretch, altered out outside the furlong marker and finished willingly for the place. TAMPA STORM moved out early then was urged along off the pace, gained leaving the backstretch, made a bid in the four path on the turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, battled with the winner into the final furlong, lost the advantage back to that foe at that juncture, fought on into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while

clear for the show. LANGUID was hustled from the gate, moved out early then was urged at the rear on the far outside, rounded the turn in the six path and improved for the last spot in the superfecta. SOLOMINI'S WORLD was rated just off the pace, dropped back near the nine-sixteenths pole, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, came out into upper stretch, passed the three-sixteenths pole in around the seven path and lacked the needed kick. ALWAYS PACKEN was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn and tired. TINSELTOWN brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along near the back, traveled around the turn in the five path and failed to rally. CHARLIE CHARMER came inward then brushed with a foe at the start, was urged early then taken in hand near the five-eighths pole before dropping back, shifted from the two path to the four path on the turn and failed to respond. SAME OLD STORY was ridden along off the pace, rounded the turn in the three path and also failed to respond. WHISKEY RUNNER was hustled from the gate, chased the pace between horses, dropped back late on the backstretch, came up empty in the two path on the turn and retreated then was eased but walked off.
