NEON BORDEAUX was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, raced off the pace while ridden along, moved closer late on the backstretch, rounded the turn in the two path, was roused inside the three-eighths pole, rallied while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, made a bid outside the furlong marker then fought between foes, brushed with the runner-up while dueling in the final sixteenth and narrowly prevailed under good handling. DARK DEVIL was hustled from the gate, angled out entering the main-track then chased the pace on the outside, traveled around the turn in the four path, gained to make an outside bid into upper stretch, took a short lead outside the furlong marker then battled outside foes, brushed with the winner while dueling with that opponent in the final sixteenth and was denied while clear for the place. GOLDEN SYMPHONY was hustled from the gate, moved to the lead outside the three-quarter pole, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked after being headed at the five-sixteenths pole, turned into the stretch under the crop, battled under a drive into the final furlong, dropped back into the final sixteenth and weakened but held the show. FORGONE went to the front and led early, lost the advantage outside the three-quarter pole then prompted the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied in the three path on the turn, regained the advantage at the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed crop into the stretch, lost the lead while between foes outside the furlong marker, dropped back into the final sixteenth and tired. HENRY'S HOPE had his head turned and was unprepared at the start, was off very slow and spotted the front several lengths, dropped well behind the rest of the field under urging, raced inside to the two path on the turn, came out into the stretch and was eased but walked off.

MASMAK just off the inside through the first turn, chased four wide thereafter coming under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, edged away to the finish to prevail. MAMA'S GOLD established the front after the start and showed the way in hand just off the inside, came under urging at the three-eighths under challenge from a pair of rivals, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared just outside the eighth pole, ran on to secure the place honors jumping tracks from foot traffic just inside forty yards to the finish. CLASSIC CATCH three wide into the first turn, tucked to the inside through that bend before chasing just off the inside down the backstretch, continued just off the inside through the far turn and went four wide into upper stretch, tipped out two to three paths straightened away and kept on to garner the show honors. NELSON AVENUE hustled from the gate, along the inside and then just off the inside through the first turn, chased three wide coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, weakened in the stretch.

YO LEVEN stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead in the three path early on the turn, shifted to the two path later on that bend then moved clear around the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to the rail while asked into upper stretch, was put to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, had the rider put the crop away into the final furlong and widened under a strong hand-ride to prove much the best. LOOKING FOR GINNY was urged along off the pace, traveled around the turn in the two path, turned into upper stretch under a drive and earned the place while no match for the winner. FREUD'S FANCY came outward at the start, showed the way off the inside while inside of a rival, moved in leaving the backstretch, lost the advantage in the two path early on the turn, moved to the rail late on the bend, lost touch with the winner inside the three-sixteenths pole, came off the rail under a drive into upper stretch and weakened but held the show. ONE GOOD RAISON was hustled from the gate, pressed then chased the pace on the outside of the leader, dropped back late on the backstretch, moved from the four path to the three path on the turn and tired. GOULDIAN was hustled from the gate then coaxed along off the pace, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn and faltered. EXOTIC CAT settled off the pace, was urged along between foen late on the backstretch, raced in the three path on the turn and also faltered. STAGED CONFLICT brushed the outside of the gate at the start, had the rider lose his right iron for just under a sixteenth of a mile then regained footing, lagged at the rear, moved from the rail to the three path on the turn, came out into upper stretch, moved in some in the lane and was eased but walked off.

RUNNIN' RAY settled off the pace, moved to the outside with six furlongs to run, was roused in the three then four path on the turn, rallied to get the lead at the three-sixteenths pole, kicked clear under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, extended the advantage inside that marker, drifted in after being given one final pop of the crop outside the sixteenth-pole, raced a solid hand-ride until the final strides then was put to lighter encouragement while much the best. ALTERNATE REALITY settled off the pace, moved in nearing the five-eighths pole, shifted from the rail to the two path early on the turn, moved to the four path near the three-eighths pole, shifted to the five path late on that bend and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. MARGIN OF AIR was urged along on the outside then forwardly placed, chased in the four then three path on the turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, raced between horses in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner then just lost the place while clear for the show. MAGNOLIA MIDNIGHT went to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, moved to a solo lead near the nine-sixteenths pole, was asked while inside on the turn, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch and gave way. SEEKING UNITY was well placed just off the pace, chased inside to the two path on the turn, dropped back in the three path into the stretch, drifted out late and tired. GUN IT pressed the pace on the outside, chased late on the backstretch, moved from the three path to the two path on the turn, remained on his inside lead in the drive and came up empty.

CLUBHOUSE dueled from the three path down the backstretch with KING KHALI to his inside, shook off that rival into the turn and showed the way remaining three wide, went five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in and held well and safe to the finish. MASTERWORK chased five then four wide coming under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch, dug in

under a drive running on to secure the place honors. BECAUSE THE NIGHT four wide in pursuit, got ridden along at the seven-sixteenths, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. ACTIVE DUTY chased five paths off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled out nine to ten wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the wire. PERFECT FLIGHT chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn coaxed along from the five-sixteenths, angled out eight to nine wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. BEACHWALKER chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide at the half mile pole placed to encouragement, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. WAKE SURF chased two to three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered no response. MY COOL HAND LUKE chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide at the top of the stretch before taking to the inside straightened away and weakened. DADS GOOD RUNNER got away to an awkward beginning when the rider's momentum was against the bit, chased three then two wide under encouragement from the seven-sixteenths, tipped three to four wide for home and tired. KING KHALI dueled early on inside of CLUBHOUSE until shaken off by that rival near the seven-sixteenths marker, gave chase under urging from the three-eighths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. INDIANQUEST chases just off the inside and then along the inside under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, made no impact.
