GOLDEN PLATE moved up after the start to prompt the pace on the outside of the leader while well out in the track, dropped from the five path to the three path early on the turn, was asked later on that bend, spun into the stretch in the four path then was carried out, gained the advantage just inside the three-sixteenths pole, fought outside of a foe into the final furlong, shook clear outside the sixteenth-pole and held under steady urging. AIRBORNE ELITE was hustled from the gate, chased the pace down the backstretch, dropped back into the turn, moved from the two path to the three path under strong urging on that bend, was driven into the stretch in the four path, dropped in inside the three-sixteenths pole, gained into the final sixteenth and showed good courage to safely secure the place. TAPIZAR'S TEMPER was hustled from the gate, settled off the early pace, passed the five-eighths pole under urging, dropped back leaving the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the three then four path, was driven into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the show. WAKE SURF was hustled to the front, showed the way down the backstretch, was given his cue in the two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path then drifted out under a left-handed crop, lost the advantage to the winner just inside the three-sixteenths pole, drifted in under a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened. BLAME IT ON DADDY lacked early speed, moved out under urging near the seven-eighths pole, went around the turn in the four then five path, spun into the stretch in the six path, angled in at the three-sixteenths pole, raced along the rail in the final furlong and lacked the needed response.

TIGER ROCKET coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside on hold until set down angled five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, drew clear to the finish to prevail. TWO DUCKS coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared just outside the eighth pole, kept on well clear of the rest to be along second best. BELLAMY chased two to three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, spun three wide into upper stretch, weakened. IRISH CRAIC hustled from the gate, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch and trailed.

INTERCEPTOR was hustled to the front, showed the way through slow fractions while inside to the two path, was asked under threat outside the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when put to a left-handed crop in upper stretch, shook off a rival outside the furlong marker and kicked clear, remained clear under a drive into the final sixteenth then was eased up late. VALENTINIAN was hustled from the gate, stalked the pace in the two to three path, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, turned into the stretch in the four path, chased the winner in the drive and safely secured the place. CHILLAX was rated under a snug hold in the two path on the first turn, moved up between horses with six furlongs to run then prompted the pace, was asked in the two path on the far turn, spun into upper stretch in the three path, lost touch with the winner coming to the furlong marker and weakened but held the show. NEON BORDEAUX was off a couple lengths behind the rest of the field, saved ground while a bit keen under restraint on the first turn, settled at the back, moved closer with five furlongs to run, saved ground while roused on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, drifted about some nearing the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. STURDY raced in the three path on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the four path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and came up empty.

SCULCOS FOLLY bobbed at the break and broke on top, showed the way in hand just off the inside patiently handled until set down spinning two to three wide into upper stretch, then drew off under a drive to prevail. MINORINCONVENIENCE bobbed at the start recovering outwards and bumping THE OBLITERATOR, chased four wide under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, improved position to secure the place honors. WAMO chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, advanced swinging just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages while clear for the show honors. ANYWAY five wide in pursuit, came under urging three furlongs from home, cornered four wide into upper stretch, weakened.
