ICE ROAD broke in at the start bumping DEBATE, raced just off the inside through the first turn in closest aim of the leader, advanced in tandem with RETAIL MAN to prompt the leader five furlongs from home, intensified the pressure into the far turn and vied between foes coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths remaining, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in dueling through the length of the stretch taking command a sixteenth from home and gamely fended off the runner up to prevail on the wire. BAD LARRY coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside through the first turn, had a pair of rivals advance and came under prompting albeit through the presence and facing very little pressure otherwise until nearing the half mile pole, vied inside a pair of rivals through the turn placed to encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive clinging to the front to the eighth pole, got collared nearing the sixteenth marker and fought on game to the finish. COMMANDPERFORMANCE three wide through the first turn, chased three wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the end. RETAIL MAN struck the off side stall at the start when the assistant starter was barely set as the latch was sprung and got away near the rear of the field, raced four then three wide through the first turn advancing to be forwardly placed, prompted the pace three wide when latching on the top pair five furlongs out, increased the pressure through the turn vying for command under urging from the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, got shaken off straightened away and weakened in the late stages. WILD BANKER along the inside through the first turn, chased four then three wide under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid to improve position to the finish. DEBATE got bumped at the start by ICE ROAD, who broke inwards, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. CO CONSPIRATOR chased along the inside and then just off the inside ridden along from the seven-sixteenths, tipped three wide into upper stretch, weakened.

BROOKLYN RHAPSODY was hustled from the gate then chased the pace, raced in the three path on the turn, gained to make a bid inside the five-sixteenths pole, passed the quarter-pole on even terms for the lead while outside of two foes, kicked clear in upper stretch, drew away under a right-handed crop remaining on her inside lead, stayed under the crop until outside the sixteenth-pole, was placed under a strong hand-ride at that point and proved much the best then was transported off the track via equine ambulance. WILDCAT ANNIE chased the leader on the outside, made a bid outside the half-mile pole, vied in the two path on the turn, took a short lead outside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage before the quarter-pole, turned into upper stretch between horses and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. YAYI NIKOLLE broke near the back of the field, was urged along off the pace, moved in leaving the backstretch, raced inside to the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. NO FACTOR bumped with a rival at the start, angled in while hustled to the front, was challenged late on the backstretch, vied inside on the turn and tired. ROSHIELL MY BELLE was urged along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. LOOKIN TO ROCK was urged along near the back, raced in the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and was no factor. SELECTIVELY SWEET bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced in the three to four path on the turn, moved to the two path near the quarter-pole, dropped back while remaining on her inside lead in the stretch and capitulated. POWER DRIVER broke out and was last away, raced at the rear under urging, traveled a bit awkwardly into strong kickback late on the backstretch, moved from the rail to the two path early on the turn, shifted out to the four path around the three-eighths pole, turned into the stretch in the five path under a right-handed crop, drifted out when switched to a left-handed crop near the three-sixteenths pole and showed little.

TWIRLING VINE chased six then five wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge a sixteenth out, took command seventy yards from the finish and edged away to the end. MAGIC BEACH broke in at the start, showed the way in hand along the inside widening away through the latter portion of the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and was set down straightened away, dug in under a drive under lone threat to the outside and was caught in the final seventy yards. SOLO FLIGHT coaxed from the gate, chased three then two wide under a ride from the three-eighths, spun three wide at the head of the stretch, ran on to secure the show honors. ROCK STAR REBEL broke a beat slow and lost his lane to BRACA, chased three to four wide under encouragement from the seven-sixteenths, went six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. DRIVE THRU chased along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, made no late headway. A KNIGHT'S COURAGE coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered no response. BRACA broke in at the start taking over the lane of the slow breaking ROCK STAR REBEL, chased three then two wide under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, cornered three wide for home, made no impact. GUNMAN JAYVO chased three to four wide under urging from the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch, made no impact. DREAMALONGWITHME chased five then four wide coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, went four wide at the top of the stretch, tired.

SOONTOBEKING bobbled at the break and was bumped by MO PLEX, who recovered outwards from a bobble, chased four then three wide coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled out five to six wide into upper stretch, closed well angling in three paths to engage the top pair to the inside, inside the final sixteenth, and was just up on the wire to score. NATIONAL IDENTITY six then five paths off the inside down the backstretch in close aim of the leader, tucked three wide into the turn and advanced on that rival to duel from midway widening away as a pair from the rest, took over narrow command swinging four to five wide into upper stretch, got carried out as MO PLEX came out to his inside two to three paths from the three-sixteenths to the eighth pole, dug in under a right handed crop and came inwards taking back those two paths and making light contact outside the sixteenth marker, dug in gamely to the finish and was nailed in the very last jump to the end. INSTANT VISION broke in and bumped with an opponent, was urged along near the rear, saved ground on the turn, turned into the stretch in the three path and failed to threaten. AWESOME ROBERTA broke out at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the four path on the turn and came up empty. SHOCK broke a step slow, bumped with a rival early, moved in while off the pace, shifted from the rail to the two path on the turn and also came up empty.
