WILL BE FAMOUS coaxed from the gate, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four then three wide through the turn getting placed to encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, swung six wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge taking command just outside the sixteenth marker, then edged clear to the finish. FIRST CLASS CAT three wide in pursuit, got ridden along at the seven-sixteenths, angled seven then six wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to procure the place honors. QUIET CONFIDENCE forwardly placed three to four paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked to the two path into the turn and advanced on the leader to take command at the five-sixteenths when put to coaxing, angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared near the sixteenth pole, kept on to preserve the show honors. GRACEFUL ROSE got bumped at the start by FOLLOW YOUR ARROW and in turn bumped SPLASHY, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home and offered up a mild bid. FOLLOW YOUR ARROW broke in at the start bumping GRACEFUL ROSE into SPLASHY, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging under threat at the three-eighths marker, yielded the front with five-sixteenths to go, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. SPLASHY got bumped at the start by GRACEFUL ROSE due to pressure from the aforementioned foe, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late going.

STEEL VENGEANCE was hustled from the gate, moved to the lead entering the main-track, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied inside to the two path on the turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, shook off the runner-up outside the sixteenth-pole and drew away under strong urging. MR. BOGAN broke out then bumped with a rival, led early then pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the two to three path on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed crop approaching the furlong marker then drifted out, was straightened by the rider before being switched back to a right-handed crop nearing the sixteenth-pole, swapped back to his inside lead shortly thereafter and proved no match for the winner while well clear for the place. BERNIE GOES BOOM was bumped just after the start, dropped back while showing no speed on the outside, went around the turn in the three path and improved for the show while no threat to the top two. SUNDAY GILT moved out outside the three-quarter pole then tracked the pace on the outside, chased late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three to four path and weakened. REVIVALISM bumped with foes on both sides at the start, settled off the pace, dropped from the five path to the two path early on the turn, moved to the three path later on that bend, pursued the leader under a drive into upper stretch and tired. GIMME GIMME settled well off the inside, was urged along passing the five-eighths pole, dropped in late on the backstretch, was ridden along in the two path for most of the turn, shifted to the three path outside the quarter-pole then turned into the stretch in the five path and failed to respond. ROCKIBLE stumbled at the start, moved out under urging early, angled in inside the three-quarter pole, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten.

SANDI'S SATIRE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand three then two wide, got let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under growing threat to the outside and held on to prevail. Following a saddle adjustment behind the gate, NIKKI BRAINBURST broke out at the start, chased four then three wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, drifted out under a left handed crop from the three-sixteenths to near the eighth pole three to four paths, had the rider switch hands with the crop to correct and rallied to issue a challenge inside the final sixteenth but missed at the end. After a saddle adjustment behind the gate, KHALI'S STORM broke out at the start filling the space left vacant by the breaking out SHERMAN'S MARLIN, chased four then three wide down the backstretch before tucking inside half a mile from home, got ridden along midway, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and kept on to the wire. THE SPLENDID ONE tossed her head and broke in at the start trading a bump with SHERMAN'S MARLIN, chased five then three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened. BARSTOOL BABE coaxed from the start, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn, came under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths, went five wide into upper stretch and tired. SHERMAN'S MARLIN broke out at the start trading a bump with THE SPLENDID ONE, chased briefly just off the inside before tipping three then four wide near the nine-sixteenths, continued four wide through the turn and then angled eight wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.

JUST BEAT THE ODDS came away in good order, showed the way down the backstretch, dictated terms in the two path on the turn, dropped to the rail outside the quarter-pole then was asked, extended the advantage under a strong hand-ride into the final furlong, drew off under two pops of the crop between the eighth-pole and the sixteenth-pole then was placed back under a strong hand-ride to the finish while much the best. TWENTY FOUR MAMBA moved out near the five-eighths pole then settled on the outside, chased in the four then three path on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong and was second best. REASONED ANALYSIS broke a half-step slow, climbed some while urged along off the pace, moved in near the nine-sixteenths pole, went around most of the turn in the two path then shifted to the three path, was driven into the stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response while able to safely secure the show. STOLEN BASE pressed the pace on the outside, chased in the two to three path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path and tired. HIGH OAK broke a step slow, moved out early then was urged along on the outside, advanced closer late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the five path and had nothing left. HE'SMYHONEYBADGER was hustled from the gate then well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn and retreated.

HORSE BE WITH YOU lunged hitting the off side stall at the start and then bumped BOSSMAKINBOSSMOVES and conceded two lengths to the front, chased three then four wide coming under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command inside the three-sixteenths, inched away briefly, then dug in under threat and just held on at the wire. JACKSON HEIGHTS broke a beat slow allowing BREW PUB to cross out into his lane and was sluggish early on growing detached at the tail of the field, chased along the inside coming under urging at the three-eighths marker, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, rallied along the inside and just missed at the finish. MONTEBELLO led early on before being engaged in a pace dispute by flanking rivals, vied four then two wide coming under coaxing three furlongs out, swung four wide into upper stretch, yielded the front inside the three-sixteenths and kept on to preserve the show honors by a nostril over one of his main pace rivals. BREW PUB broke out at the start taking over the lane of the slow breaking JACKSON HEIGHTS, advanced to vie five then three wide outside a pair of rivals coming under encouragement at the three-eighths, swung five wide into upper stretch, kept on dueling to the finish with the aforementioned foe but was ultimately nosed on the wire for the show honors. ALLURE OF MONEY advanced after the start to vie inside a pair from six furlongs out, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, took the inside route into upper stretch clinging to command, yielded the front straightened away and weakened in the late stages. BOSSMAKINBOSSMOVES got bumped at the start by HORSE BE WITH YOU coming outwards and conceded three lengths to the front, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn ridden along from the seven-sixteenths, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and made no impact.
