SHAKIN THE BELLE showed speed then chased the leading duo on the outside, made a bid in the three path on the turn, took the advantage under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, shook clear nearing the furlong marker, was given one final pop of a left-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole then held under a strong hand-ride to the finish. DIALBOLICO was well placed down the backstretch, shifted from the two path to the four path while roused on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive, pursued the winner willingly to the finish and was second best. REMEMBER THE CHIEF disputed the pace on the inside of a rival, vied along the rail while inside of two foes on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. SMOKEY PLACES veered out at the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch between horses, dropped back while remaining on his inside lead in the drive and tired. MANO E MANO dropped back then was urged along well off the pace, traveled around the turn in the three path and was no factor. PERFECT CREED was last to commence, raced at the rear under urging, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten.

LADY RAINICORN coaxed from the gate, chased three then four wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged clear to the finish. CRIMSON QUEEN dueled inside of TWIRLY with six and a half furlongs to run, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, proved no match for the top one while running on to preserve the place honors. OUR PREFERRED PAL broke in at the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging at the three-eighths, spun three wide into upper stretch and improved position to procure the show honors. GIANT AT WORK brushed the off side stall at the start, chased four then three wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened. TWIRLY coaxed from the start, led early on before being engaged in a duel with CRIMSON QUEEN with six and a half furlongs remaining, dueled three then two wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, went four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the stretch. KNICKKNACK chased along the inside down the backstretch before heading four to five wide through the turn coming under encouragement briefly at the three-eighths, cornered three wide into upper stretch and trailed.

BRODERICK went to the front, showed the way on the inside of rivals, vied along the rail on the turn, responded well when asked outside the quarter-pole, shook clear under a right-handed crop while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch, continued under the crop until outside the sixteenth-pole, stayed on his inside lead to the finish and prevailed under a strong hand-ride. VERY SATISFACTORY prompted the pace on the outside, was given his cue near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied in the three then two path under urging on the turn, lost touch with the winner under a drive in upper stretch and was outfinished while well clear for the place. LAIRD OF MAGNOLIA was hustled from the gate then bumped with a foe, moved in entering the main-track, reached the rail near the three-quarter pole, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the two then three path on the turn, pursued the top two under a drive into upper stretch and weakened but was clear for the show. NILRUC was carried in entering the main-track, dropped back under urging around the three-quarter pole then moved out, dropped in to save ground on the turn, came out into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. BELMONT UNION was hustled from the gate, raced towards the back, was urged along in the two then three path on the turn, steadied off heels while carried out to the five path into upper stretch, drifted in under a right-handed crop in the vicinity of the furlong marker and failed to rally. NOBLE ONE moved out with seven furlongs to run, was urged along on the outside, rounded the turn in the five path and failed to respond. TIP OF THE BOOT was hustled from the gate then bumped with a rival, raced just off the pace, dropped back under urging late on the backstretch then moved out, shifted from the three path to the two path on the turn and retreated. LCGOLUCKY raced towards the back, fell well behind while floating from the four path to the six path on the turn, came further out into the stretch and was eased but walked off.
