BLLENHEIM BABY showed speed then moved in near the three-quarter pole, stalked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure in the two to three path on the turn, took the advantage while asked into the stretch then kicked clear and drew away under steady urging to prove much the best. HEAVENS LEE moved out just inside the three-quarter pole, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, chased in the three to four path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. CHURNING BERNI raced just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, spun into upper stretch off the inside, chased into the final furlong then moved out and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. MIA NIPOTINA was urged along at the rear, angled in early on the backstretch, went around the turn in the two then three path, turned into the stretch in the four path and failed to rally. FURRY FOX went to the front, moved with six furlongs to run, was asked while inside to the two path on the turn, lost the advantage into the stretch and tired. CHA CHA WREN was urged along on the outside, moved in late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond.

NIGHTSCOPE coaxed from the gate, established the front shortly after the start and showed the way lightly coaxed just off the inside down the backstretch, came under pressure from a pair of rivals through the turn while remaining just off the inside, continued in the two path into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in and held well and safe to the finish kept to task. HIP HOP DANCER coaxed from the start, chased three wide in closest aim of the leader, advanced in tandem with RAYNHAM HALL through the turn to apply pressure to the top one coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch and was shaken off a bit to the furlong grounds, offered up a mild bid. RAYNHAM HALL coaxed from the gate, chased four wide advancing to prompt the top pair through the turn under a ride from three furlongs out, continued fur wide for home, offered up a mild kick. ROSEBERNS DREAM got brushed at the break by RELI'S CRUISER, chased five wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch and tired. TANK GIRL broke a half a beat slow, chased along the inside down the backstretch until shifted out two then three wide through the turn coming under encouragement midway, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and tired. RELI'S CRUISER broke in at the start brushing ROSEBERNS DREAM, chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, tipped four wide into upper stretch and trailed.

BIG DIG went around the first turn in the two to three path, was rated on the outside, ranged up to make a bid late on the backstretch, vied in the four path on the far turn, took the lead while asked at the top of the stretch, responded well while battling with the runner-up in the drive and proved best under strong urging. PAM PAM was hustled from the gate, raced in the two path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside of the leader, took the advantage with a half-mile to run, was roused in the two path on the far turn, lost the advantage to the winner at the quarter-pole, fought on well with that foe in the stretch but missed while clear for the place. ROYAL BOBBIE was last to commence, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled at the rear, was urged along in the three then four path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and improved well out in the track for the show. HIGHER FORCE was hustled from the gate, traveled around the first turn in the three path, tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, made a bid with a half-mile to run, vied in the three path under urging while between foes on the far turn, dropped back late on that bend and tired. RACING COLORS settled on the inside, dropped back with five furlongs to run, moved from the rail to the three path on the far turn and failed to threaten. LUCKFORYOU was sent hard to the front, showed the way on the inside, lost the lead under urging late on the backstretch and stopped then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.

DAYTONA MOONSHINE coaxed from the gate, raced DAYTON then three wide through the first turn at the tail of the field, went five paths off the inside down the backstretch and took closer order midway, continued five then four wide through the far turn under encouragement from three furlongs out, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, briefly inched away and then got leg weary in the very late stages but held on to the wire to prevail. GOOD COP raced along the inside and then just off the inside through the first turn, chased four paths off the rail down the backstretch, began an advance into the far turn tucking three wide at the seven-sixteenths forcing UNCLE BARRIE to check in behind inside that station, took over command inside five-sixteenths to go, swung four to five wide for home, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, fought on to the wire. INONIT lunged at the break bumping LUCKY DRAGON, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, got checked at the quarter pole when LUCKY DRAGON tipped out directly in front in the three path, went four to five wide into upper stretch re-engaged by the rider, offered up late foot with good courage to secure the show honors. UNCLE BARRIE raced three then two wide through the first turn, chased three wide forwardly placed down the backstretch, had GOOD COP advance outside inside the half mile pole, then got forced to check when that rival tucked in front at the seven-sixteenths and altered out four wide briefly, went seven wide into upper stretch and showed good courage to come again nearing the finish. LUCKY DRAGON got bumped at the start by the lunging INONIT, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths marker, spun two then three wide into upper stretch forcing INONIT to check in behind, then weakened in the stretch. BECK'S DREAMER showed the way in hand along the inside and then just off the inside coming under a ride three furlongs out when under threat from GOOD COP to the outside, yielded the front just inside five-sixteenths remaining, spun two to three wide for home and tired. PERFECT SHEPHARD three then two wide through the first turn, chased just off the inside under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, went six wide into upper stretch, faltered, and was eased home to the finish.
