GRACE REFORMED was sent hard from the gate, showed speed then was well placed just off the pace, saved ground while asked on the turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole, made a bid between horses while under a drive into upper stretch, battled with two foes into the final furlong, fought with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while clear for the place. EMBRACEABLE GAL was fractious in the gate, moved up to get the lead then was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch, battled inside of the top two under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but held the show. FIRST PITCH coaxed from the gate, cut the pace from the two path uncontested, came under light coaxing midway on the far turn, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive and was kept to task to the finish. ASSET MANAGEMENT coaxed from the start, raced three then two wide through the first turn, chased three wide down the backstretch before tucking inside into the far turn, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, went five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. DIO ROMANO four wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. LUCKY DRAGON stumbled at the start, chased along the inside coming under urging at the three-eighths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. KISMEHOLDMETHRLME brushed the near side stall at the start, chased along the inside and then just off the inside ridden along from the half mile pole, angled out five wide into upper stretch, improved position to the wire. MAGNI four then three wide through the first turn, chased five then three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, went nine wide into upper stretch and tired. ROMEO VOID chased just off the inside through the first turn before tipping six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked back to the two path through the far turn, went three wide for home and tired. HAVE A CIGAR coaxed from the gate, went five wide into the first turn before tucking four then three wide through that bend, chased three wide down the backstretch and into the far turn, came under urging near the midway point on that bend and began to retreat, went six to seven wide into upper stretch, folded, and was eased home to the finish.
