FLOGE broke in a step at the start bumping SHE'S COMPLICATED, chased five then four wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, took over the front at the three-sixteenths marker, edged away to the finish to prevail. FOXY CARA three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, continued three wide into upper stretch taking over brief and narrow command just inside the quarter pole, got displaced with three-sixteenths to go, ran on to secure the place honors. LUNA MOTH chased two to three wide under a ride with seven-sixteenths to run, angled out six wide into upper stretch, kept on to procure the show honors. TROUBLED LUCK crossed steadily to the two path after the start when forwardly placed, prompted the pace of HAUNTRESS from the outside coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch in retreat, tired. SHE'S COMPLICATED got bumped at the start by FLOGE, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. HAUNTRESS cut the pace along the inside under some pressure from TROUBLED LUCK to the outside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch yielding command, then tired through to the finish.

GULFY showed speed under coaxing, took the lead on the inside of a rival while five furlongs to run, vied inside on the turn, was asked inside the three-eighths pole, lost the lead narrowly at the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the two path while put to a left-handed crop, dueled inside of the runner-up, drifted out near the furlong marker, continued to duel with the runner-up while jostling with that foe and gamely prevailed under strong urging. BOLD LOVE was rated in a good position down the backstretch, shifted from the two path to the three path early on the turn, ranged up to make a bid outside the five-sixteenths pole, took the lead while roused at the quarter-pole then spun into the stretch in the four path, dueled outside of the winner while further out in the track, jostled with that foe in the final furlong and was denied while well clear for the place. SOUTHEASTERN showed speed and led early, lost the lead near the five-eighths pole, pressed the pace on the outside, chased in the three then two path on the turn and weakened while clear for the show. ANYWAY settled at the rear, moved out outside the five-eighths pole, was urged along late on the backstretch then dropped in, raced inside to the two path on the turn and came up empty. HONG KONG PHOOEY was taken under a tight hold early then tracked the pace on the outside, came under urging late on the backstretch, dropped back in the four then three path on the turn and faltered then was distanced in the final furlong. TOP PLAYER stumbled badly at the start and unseated the rider then was walked off after being apprehended by an outrider.

TIMAEUS coaxed from the gate to the front, showed the way in hand just off the inside patiently handled and in the clear, got set down spinning four wide into upper stretch, held well and clear to the finish. PRINCE OF TRUTH four then three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled six wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. SKYLANDER chased three then two wide under a ride from midway on the turn, angled seven wide into upper stretch and kept on to the wire. SCARAMANGA coaxed from the start, chased along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, weakened. SIN NOMBRE chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch before heading four then three wide through the turn under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, tired. MISTER J T four paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked to the two path briefly at the half mile pole before making his way to the rail through the turn, got ridden along from three furlongs out, angled four wide at the head of the stretch and tired.

NANTZ went to the front and showed the way, opened up in the two path on the turn, drew off under a drive into the final furlong and maintained a safe advantage under strong urging. SUPERPOWER was hustled from the gate, moved up then was taken in hand briefly outside the five-eighths pole, shifted from the rail to the four path on the turn, spun into the stretch under a drive and finished willingly to just get the place. MAGNI raced well back in the field, angled from the two path to the five path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and also finished willingly but just missed the place while well clear for the show. FISCAL DRAG broke out at the start, raced well back on the outside, moved from the three path to the five path early on the turn, angled in late on that bend, reached the rail coming to the quarter-pole and improved position. MAJESTIC ARC chased the pace, went around most of the turn in the three path then dropped to the two path and tired. STRAND ROAD was urged along on the outside, rounded most of the turn in the four path then dropped to the three path and came up empty. DAMAGE was hustled from the gate then urged along on the outside, dropped from the four path to the two path on the turn and failed to respond. FORGONE chased the pace on the inside of a rival, dropped back leaving the backstretch, moved from the three to four path on the turn and retreated then was eased in the final furlong but walked off. INSTANT SUCCESS was hustled from the gate, steadied near the

three-quarter pole, dropped back to the rear of the field, saved ground for most of the turn then shifted to the three path and was also eased but walked off.
