LONCHURA coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside through the first turn and down the backstretch before tipping to the two path through the far turn, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths and swung three then two wide into upper stretch straightened away, drew clear under a drive to prevail. FARM HOUSE chased two then three wide under a ride from the three-eighths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one and dug in to hold on for the place honors by a head. LOOKING FOR GINNY coaxed from the start, chased along the inside and then briefly just off the inside coming under prolonged urging at the half mile pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to miss for the place honors while never threatening the winner and well clear of the rest. GAME LIKE REYANA coaxed from the gate, raced four wide into the turn before tucking three then two wide, chased three to four wide down the backstretch and three wide through the far turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths, cornered four wide for home and tired. SHERMAN'S MARLIN coaxed from the start, raced three wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide just off the pace, came under urging in retreat at the seven-sixteenths, angled out five to six wide into upper stretch and was eased home to the end.

IRISH JACKSON bumped with rivals on both sides at the start then was squeezed back some in tight quarters, moved out then settled off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the four path, was driven into upper stretch in the six path, pursued the winner into the final furlong, gained on that foe into the final sixteenth and got up to prevail. LADY ARWEN was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, settled towards the rear, was roused in the five path on the turn, kept on in pursuit of the winner in the stretch, gained into the final sixteenth and finished willingly to get up for the place. POSEIDON'S MIST switched out outside the five-eighths pole then tracked the leader on the outside, rounded the turn in the two path, was given her cue outside the five-sixteenths pole, took the advantage inside the three-sixteenths pole, led under a drive into the final sixteenth then was overtaken and caught for the place while able to get the show. LA GROTTTE was hustled from the gate then chased the pace, raced in the three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the five path, angled in outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. TRADE SECRET bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground while urged along on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and also lacked the needed kick. DASHING DELLA angled in while going to the front then showed the way with a clear advantage, raced inside on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came off the rail into upper stretch, lost the advantage inside the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. LAST GLORY broke awkwardly and was off slow, spotted the front a few lengths, settled at the rear on the far outside, angled in leaving the backstretch, dropped to the rail early on the turn, saved ground from that point into the stretch and failed to threaten.

GOLDCREST coaxed from the gate, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn patiently handled until set down spinning three to four wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge a furlong out and was directed out as **GHOSTLY GIRL** came out in front, had that rival come out once more a sixteenth out but was latched on by then before taking command seventy yards from the finish, then inched away to the wire. **GHOSTLY GIRL** coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside under some pressure from a pair, tucked inside through the turn and remained on hold until roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, came out a path or two under left rein encouragement a furlong out, dug in under threat and came out again under a busy left rein near the sixteenth pole when her main danger latched on outside, got collared with seventy yards to the finish while well clear for the place honors. **SHEZANARCTICQUEEN** chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch, improved position to the finish. **EVERLYS GIRL** coaxed from the gate, prompted the pace of **GHOSTLY GIRL** from the outside three then two wide under encouragement from the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened. **JOLLY MISS JILL** coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and tired. **BALENCIAGA BETTY** coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide for home, made no impact. **JACKIE THE JOKER** forwardly placed five then four wide down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn and came under a ride midway, tipped six wide into upper stretch, tired in the drive.

BROADWAY LIGHTS bobbled at the break, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the show honors isolated between the top pair and the pair behind. MOONLIT DRIVE hustled from the start, cut the pace from the two path under pressure from the outside, tucked inside through the turn and was collared with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. SHADYSIDE chased inside briefly before tipping out to the six path, chased six then five wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.

DAMAGE dropped back while urged along, fell well off the pace, went around the turn in the four then five path, turned into upper stretch in the seven path, remained on his inside lead until just before the eighth-pole then swapped to the proper lead, rallied outside in the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. RUNAMOR was bumped at the start and forced in, showed speed then contested the pace loosely between horses, vied in the two path on the turn, brushed with a foe into upper stretch, shook off that rival into the final furlong, led until the final strides but was denied while well clear for the place. GORZO broke in then was hustled, showed speed then pressed the pace on the inside of two foes, dropped back along the rail on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the two path and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. CAPT JAX PARROW moved in while rated just off the pace entering the main-track, shifted out near the five-eighths pole then tracked the pace, ranged up leaving the backstretch, made a bid in the four then three path on the turn, took the lead inside the five-sixteenths pole, brushed with the runner-up into upper stretch, dueled with that foe until near the furlong marker and weakened. RAGTIME PRANKSTER broke in then bumped with a foe and stumbled, pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back in the three then four path on the turn and tired. DANZIGER came inward at the start, dropped well back under urging, saved ground on the turn and failed to menace. UNCLE BARRIE broke in then bumped with an opponent, was urged along near the back, went around the turn in the two then three path and failed to threaten. SOLOMINI'S LEGACY bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along off the pace, dropped back in the three path on the turn and came up empty. CLASSIC MARTINI had his saddle adjusted behind the gate, broke in then bumped with foes on both sides, steadied off heels early then dropped back,

saved ground on the turn and was no factor.
