POINT OF REFERENCE coaxed from the gate, raced five paths off the inside in aim of the leader down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn and advanced to take command with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to prevail. IRRESISTIBLE coaxed from the start, chased four then three wide patiently handled until set down angled five to six wide into upper stretch, ran on to chase the winner home well clear of the rest and along second best. MOONLIT chased five to six paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked four wide through the turn urged along from three furlongs out, went three to four wide at the head of the stretch and weakened. ALMA'S LAW got bumped at the break by COLLECTIVE BARGAIN, who broke outwards, attended that rival to the outside three then two wide between foes and came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, spun three wide for home, tired in the stretch. COLLECTIVE BARGAIN broke out at the break bumping ALMA'S LAW, established the front inside seven furlongs to run and showed the way in hand along the inside under close watch from a pair to the outside, got placed to a ride midway on the turn, yielded the front with five-sixteenths to go, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and folded.

CRUSHED IT was well placed just off the pace, gained along the rail into the turn then took the lead just inside the seven-sixteenths pole, moved clear into the lane, drew away under a drive into the final sixteenth then was eased up while much the best. ELIMINATE broke a step slow, dropped to the rear of the field then moved out, was roused while shifting from the two path to the four path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the six path and finished willingly for the place. UNLIMITEDPOTENTIAL moved in while going to the front then showed the way, dropped from the three path to the two path early on the turn, lost the advantage just inside the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back in the three path into the stretch and tired while clear for the show. BIG BLUE LINE was hustled from the gate, moved out leaving the chute, raced just off the pace, chased in the two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed response. BRIGADIER GENERAL tracked the pace on the outside, came under urging late on the backstretch, chased in the four then three path on the turn, dropped back in the five path into upper stretch and capitulated. THREE TECHNIQUE was last into stride then dropped back, angled in while settling well back in the field, was urged along late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, spun into the stretch in the two path and failed to threaten.

SHERIFF BIANCO traded a small bump at the break with SCOOT DADDY, chased just off the inside briefly before tipping out three wide and in the clear soon after, got nudged four wide near the half mile pole by SCOOT DADDY and then got floated out five wide at the three-eighths marker by that rival, angled six wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and was up in the last jumps to score. CARVELLIAN QUEST broke out at the start, dueled from the two path with SPIRIT DRAGON to his inside, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung three wide for home, took over sole command at the three-sixteenth pole, dug in under growing late threat to the outside and was caught in the final strides to the wire. SCOOT DADDY traded a minor bump at the start with SHERIFF BIANCO, chased just off the inside before tipping three wide and nudging that same rival out a path near the half mile pole, floated four wide three furlongs from home carrying out SHERIFF BIANCO five wide at that station, tipped five wide into upper stretch, kept on to the end. SPIRIT DRAGON broke out at the break, dueled inside of CARVELLIAN QUEST from the get go coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the fight for command for good with three-sixteenths remaining and faltered in the drive.

SWEET LAURA bobbled at the start but broke with the field, settled well off the pace, gained late on the backstretch, made a bid in the five then four path on the turn, dropped to the three path while taking the lead late on that bend, shook clear into the stretch and drew away under steady urging. MINNESOTA MUNNY brushed with a rival at the start while hustled, tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied in the three then two path on the turn, lost touch with the winner into upper stretch and proved no match while clear for the place. PISTOL LIZ ABLAZEN was away awkwardly, raced well back on the outside under urging, moved from the three path to the five path on the turn and was along for the show. BOURBON SERENGETI was hustled from the gate, established a good position towards the front, chased inside on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and weakened. RACHEL'S ROCK went to the front, showed the way with a clear advantage under some restraint, lost the lead while dropping from the two path to the inside on the turn and gave way. SHE'S COOL came inward at the start then brushed with a foe, settled on the outside, gained late on the backstretch then made a bid, vied in the four then three path on the turn, dropped back late on that bend and capitulated. SHETALKSTOMUCH raced well back in the field, rounded the turn in the two path, spun into the stretch in the three path and showed little. SHARP SPARK settled off the pace, rounded the first turn in the two path, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the final turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. MARGIE'S FUN SON veered out and hit the gate, traveled around the first turn in the four path, settled on the outside, chased in the four path on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the five path and also proved no match for the winner then narrowly missed the place but earned the show. CENTAVO rounded the first turn in the two path, tracked the pace, chased in the two path on the far turn and weakened. ADVENTURIST went around the first turn in the three path, settled off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, traveled around the far turn in the five then four path and came up empty. GOOD BALI settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole and failed to respond. UNBRIDLED BOMBER was taken under a snug hold early, dropped from the two path to the inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went around the far turn in the two then three path and also failed to respond. BOB JOHN RAY went to the front, showed the way on the inside, lost the lead at the seven-sixteenths pole, vied along the rail under urging on the far turn, dropped back late on that bend and faded. KEVIN'S STRIKE was hard held towards the rear early, raced in the five path on the first turn, settled outside at the rear, was urged along while dropping from the four path to the inside on the far turn, tossed his head slightly a few times in upper stretch and failed to respond.

PINK ROSE coaxed from the gate, chased five then four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, went five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive taking command seventy yards from home, then inched away in the late stages. BEST IMPRESSION five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and continued just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. COQUITO coaxed from the gate, raced seven paths off the inside down the backstretch forwardly placed, tucked three wide through the turn and came under a ride midway, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, ran on through to the finish. MURSAL four wide in aim of the leader, tucked to the two path half a mile from home and advanced to take command three furlongs out, remained patiently handled until roused taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under a drive under threat from a trio, got collared seventy yards from home, kept on and was outfinished in the final jumps to the wire. GOLDEN EIB MICRPHN chased three paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking inside into the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths tipping off the inside as the former leader backed away, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, made mild ground while making no headway to the end. EDISTRUDIS coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside, got placed to encouragement and was displaced from the front three furlongs from home, went just off the inside into upper stretch in retreat and tired. LIKA ROLLING STONE chased along the inside coaxed along from the half mile pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, tired. WHISTLER'S STYLE was away awkwardly then devoid of speed early on, grew detached at the tail of the field chasing just off the inside and then along the inside, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch and made no impact. FARM HOUSE coaxed from the gate, chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under prolonged encouragement

from half a mile out, swung four wide for home and offered little.
