SHORT SHIFT coaxed from the gate, dueled from the two path down the backstretch with SPLASHY to her outside, steadily shook away just off the inside through the turn, got let out spinning four wide into upper stretch, edged clear to the eighth pole, dug in and held well to prevail. SPLASHY dueled from the three path with the aforementioned foe to her inside through to the half mile pole, got shaken off a bit in the turn and came under coaxing three wide at the three-eighths marker, swung five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive running on to chase the winner home while safe for the place honors. CAROL T coaxed from the gate, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under urging from midway, tipped four to five wide at the head of the stretch, kept on to the finish. INTENTIOUS bobbed at the break, chased four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, went seven then six wide straightened away at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild bid. FIRST CLASS CAT chased three then two wide down the backstretch before tucking inside at the half mile pole, got pushed along with seven-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, stayed on one paced but was outkicked at the end. EASY PLAY coaxed from the gate, raced just off the duel four wide coming under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch and was outkicked through to the finish. TURRIGA coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide under a ride from midway on the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch, tired.

SAVE US MELANIA broke alertly from the inside post, was well placed just off the pace, drafted inside to the two path on the turn, was roused inside the five-sixteenths pole then shifted to the three path, gained in the four path into the stretch, made a bid outside the furlong marker, took the lead under the crop outside the sixteenth-pole then edged clear late under a strong hand-ride. SMOKIN' HOT KITTY settled on the outside, was asked late on the backstretch, gained into the turn, made a bid in the four then three path on that bend, held a narrow advantage while battling outside of two foes under a drive in upper stretch, fought with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while clear for the place. GRIDLOCK broke out at the start, angled in while showing speed, contested the pace on the inside of an opponent, vied inside on the turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail into the stretch, battled under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but earned the show. ADELEKE established a forward position then raced just off the pace on the outside, made a bid between horses in the four then three path on the turn, battled with multiple foes under a drive into the final furlong and tired. OUR LIBERTY BELLE settled off the pace, was roused late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three then four path and lacked the needed response. I'M BUZZY was hustled from the gate then dropped back before settling, moved closer late on the backstretch, dropped back under urging while inside to the two path on the turn and came up empty. BACKSTRETCH ROSE dropped back under urging while showing no speed, moved in while falling well behind the rest of the field, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail late on that bend, swung out to the five path into the stretch and was no factor. SPRING MAGIC disputed the pace on the outside, was urged along in the two to three path on the turn, dropped back with three furlongs to run then fell further back and faded.

LATTA chased three then two wide coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, then edged away kept to task to the wire. DOT'S DOLLAR coaxed from the gate, chased inside briefly until tipped three wide with five and a half furlongs to run, advanced on the leader to knock heads with that foe from the three-eighths pole through to the quarter pole when taking narrow command, swung three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat to the outside and yielded just outside the eighth pole, ran on through to the finish clear of the rest and along second best. BAD LARRY climbed early on and grew detached at the tail of the field, chased three then two wide down the backstretch under coaxing from the get go before tucking inside through the turn, swung three wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. GRAYWING dueled inside of CHUCK WILLIS from the get go down the backstretch while along the rail, shook off that challenger with seven-sixteenths to go and was confronted by DOT'S DOLLAR three furlongs from home, dueled with that rival to his outside through to the quarter pole when displaced from command, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, tired in the drive. CHUCK WILLIS (IRE) coaxed from the gate, dueled from the two path with the aforementioned foe to his inside, got shaken off with seven-sixteenths to go and came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide at the top of the lane in retreat, tired in the stretch.

MO RHODES broke last and sluggish from the gate without incident, chased three to four paths off the inside past the stands the initial time before heading four wide through the first turn, tipped out to be six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then went five to six wide through the far turn coming under urging midway, advanced mildly through the latter portion of the turn and went six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge inside the final furlong and was just up in the shadow of the wire to score. DOUBLE YOUR MONEY chased four wide throughout coming under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, continued four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the eighth pole, dug in under lone late threat and was nailed on the wire and forced to settle for the place honors. STRAPPED got bumped at the start by WINNIN'ONWEEKENDS, who broke outwards, and then lost his lane to that rival, settled three to four wide in pursuit, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. SEEKING UNITY struck the near side stall at the start and came under coaxing to be forwardly placed two to three wide in closest aim of the leader, remained patiently handled until put to coaxing just inside three furlongs remaining, advanced to take command swinging two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat from flanking rivals and was collared just inside the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. WINNIN'ONWEEKENDS broke out at the start bumping STRAPPED before taking over his lane, cut the pace along the inside past the stands and through the first turn and then just off the inside down the backstretch and through the far turn coming under urging at the five-sixteenths when under pressure for the initial time by SEEKING UNITY to the outside, took the inside route into upper stretch and was displaced from the front at the quarter pole, dug in under a drive prominent to the furlong grounds then weakened in the late going. BOLD ENDEAVOR broke out brushing the off side stall at the start and then FIRST TRUMPET, chased three then two wide through the stretch the first time and through the first turn, remained just off the inside down the backstretch before tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the

drive. FIRST TRUMPET got brushed at the start by BOLD ENDEAVOR, who broke outwards, chased five wide past the stands the initial time before heading five wide through the first turn, chased four to five wide down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the far turn coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to go in retreat, tipped five wide at the top of the stretch and tired. TAPARINO shied out at the start filling the space left vacant by the breaking outwards WINNIN'ONWEEKENDS, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, cornered three to four wide at the head of the lane and made no impact.

FEDUPWITHTHEFED shied in at the start filling the space left vacant by CALISA veering in, chased four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths marker, continued four wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and seized command forty yards from the finish before inching away to the wire. FOREVER TO GO vied with a pair to her inside while eight paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the three path into the turn, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung six wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under threat and was caught with forty yards to the finish while clear for the place honors. CLOUDY CHANCE forwardly placed seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide into the turn and chased the pace dispute up front in closest range coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, went eight wide into upper stretch, kept on under a drive to secure the show honors. DEAR MOON coaxed from the gate, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coaxed along from three furlongs out, swung five wide at the top of the stretch, closed well to the finish. PATIENCE N GRACE chased along the inside under a ride from the three-eighths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. SUNSHINE LILY broke out at the start under coaxing and bumped JULITA, vied inside a pair of rivals four paths off the inside before tucking to the rail inside the half mile pole, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in prominent to the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. LOLLIPOPS chased just off the inside coaxed along from the three-eighths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, made no headway. JULITA got bumped at the start by SUNSHINE LILY, vied loosely between foes from the five path down the backstretch and then between rivals in the two path through the turn coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, swung four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late going. TRULLI MAGIC dwelt at the start conceding at minimum eight to nine lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, went eight wide into upper stretch, showed good courage to improve position to the finish. INAMORATA chased six then four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals to the wire. TURBO TRAIN chased three then two wide coming under urging at the three-eighths, swung three wide into upper stretch, weakened. CALISA veered in at the start bumping NIGHT JASMINE and forcing that rival to steady out and then bumped TIZN'T ANYMORE, chased two to three wide under a ride from midway on the turn, went six to seven wide for home and tired. NIGHT JASMINE got bumped and forced to steady at the start when CALISA took over her lane and conceded five lengths to the front, chased three to four wide down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn, angled four wide for home and made no impact. TIZN'T ANYMORE got bumped at the start by pressure from CALISA, chased two to three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths pole, swung three wide at the head of the stretch and was unable to make an impact.
