EL GRANDE O tipped out just after the start to be outside his only rival and four paths off the rail, came under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, latched on to the outside nearing the quarter pole and was floated seven wide into upper stretch, came in slightly as VICTORY WAY came out and traded a bump just outside the eighth pole, seized command at that station, dug in gamely to prevail. VICTORY WAY broke sharply and to the front under hustling, showed the way in hand three paths off the inside down the backstretch and through the turn, had the aforementioned foe latch on nearing the quarter pole and swung six wide into upper stretch carrying that rival seven wide, came outwards nearing the eighth pole as EL GRANDE O came in slightly and traded a bump just before being headed for command, fought on to the finish.

PROUD FOOT switched out after the leading duo crossed in front early, raced just off the pace on the outside, stalked the leader in the three path on the turn, was asked while taking the lead in the four path into upper stretch, shook clear under the crop outside the furlong maker and proved best under strong urging. ALWAYS ANGELS brushed with a rival at the start, settled under some urging, was roused for more while shifting from the rail to the three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the five path and willingly earned the place. BEIRA brushed with a foe at the start, settled at the rear, was roused while moving from the two path to the five path on the turn, came into upper stretch in the seven path and lacked the needed kick while improving position for the show. A MAIZE ZING DOTIE angled in early, pressed the pace on the outside, was asked while dropping back in the two path on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. CURLIN'S MAGIC settled on the outside, was roused in the four path on the turn, was driven into upper stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response. SHORT SHIFT was hustled from the gate then angled in quickly while going to the front, showed the way on the inside of a rival, inched clear along the rail midway through the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage into upper stretch and faded.

HELLO BEAUTY four wide into the first turn, tucked three then two wide through that bend settling to show the way in hand just off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing just outside the quarter pole and spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under growing threat to the outside and came out to look that rival in the eye, repelled the challenge inside the final furlong holding well to the finish kept to task. DEVILS ARROW coaxed from the gate, raced three wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, got rebuffed inside that station and ran on well clear of the rest for the place honors. LAST GLORY three wide into the first turn, chased along the inside coming under encouragement three furlongs from home, cornered three wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the late stages. MATHEA raced three wide through the first turn and then three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the far turn coming under a ride at the three-eighths marker, angled out five to six wide into upper stretch and weakened. TOWER TWENTY TWO raced just off the inside through the first turn and then four to five paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked three wide half a mile from home and came under urging midway on the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch and tired. GRACE REFORMED chased along the inside and then just off the inside under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, made no impact.

GOOD COP broke in then was corrected by the rider, moved up to be well placed while rated under restraint, tugged keenly on the bit passing the five-eighths pole, was hard held while rank behind horses under restraint at the nine-sixteenths pole, drafted inside to the two path on the turn, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied in the three path while finding room into the stretch, chased under a drive into the final furlong, gained to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with the runner-up to the finish and held under strong urging. POWERED BY COAL showed speed between horses, dropped back nearing the three-quarter pole then moved to the outside, gained to make a bid in the three path on the turn, took a short lead at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch, fought on well in the final furlong, battled on even terms with the winner coming to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. BECK'S DREAMER was bumped at the start then forced in and dropped back, moved in with five furlongs to run, gained under urging while shifting from the two path to the four path on the turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the show. NOGUCHI was hustled from the gate, contested the pace on the inside of an opponent, was asked late on the backstretch, vied along the rail while inside of two foes on the turn, lost the advantage coming to the quarter-pole, battled inside several rivals under a drive into the final sixteenth and weakened. CAT FAST was hustled from the gate then came in and jostled with a foe, disputed the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path on the turn, passed the five-sixteenths pole between horses, battled between foes under a drive into the final furlong, dropped back into the final sixteenth and faltered. CHARLIE HUSTLE dropped back then settled near the rear, fell well behind late on the backstretch, rounded the turn in the four path without being urged and was eased but walked off.

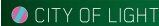

MO ATTITUDE broke out at the start, was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the three path, dropped to the two path under a drive into upper stretch, rallied in the final furlong and closed strongly to get up in the final sixteenth and win going away. I'M KIDDING broke out at the start, angled in while speeding to the front, went around the turn in the two path then spun into the stretch in the three path, drifted out under pressure near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while just able to get the place. RARE SOCIETY angled out early then was urged along towards the front, chased in the three to four path on the turn, came into the stretch in the five path, pursued the runner-up in the drive and finished willingly to just miss the place while narrowly able to get the show. SAUCY SIX lacked early speed, dropped from the three path to the two path early on the turn, swung out to the seven path into upper stretch and improved with late energy to just miss the show. TWIRLING LULU angled in while showing speed then chased the leader on the outside, went around the turn in the three path, pursued the runner-up under a drive into the final sixteenth and weakened. OKLAHOMA SMOKE was urged along on the outside, traveled around the turn in the two path, was driven into upper stretch in the six path, drifted in inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. DOPPIO ESPRESSO was urged along at the rear, rounded the turn in the two path and was no factor. ST. BRIGID'S CROSS was well placed down the backstretch, dropped back with a half-mile to run, came up empty along the rail on the turn and retreated then was pulled up in the stretch before being transported off the track via equine ambulance.
