MALU coaxed from the gate, raced three wide into the first turn before clearing a pair of rivals to tuck to the rail midway on that bend, showed the way in hand three paths off the inside down the backstretch and then from the two path through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in and held safe to prevail. BELLS BEACH chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive offering up a mild kick to secure the place honors, latching on the leader as she hit the wire. GOLD LIGHTNING stumbled at the start, raced three then two wide through the first turn before chasing four then three wide, came under urging with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. SOUNDBITE got bumped at the start by RISING INFLATION, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. RISING INFLATION broke in at the start bumping SOUNDBITE, chased three wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths, went six wide into upper stretch, trailed throughout.

CHASING DAYLIGHT went to the front, drifted out near the seven-eighths pole, went clear outside the five-eighths pole then moved inward, raced inside to the two path on the turn, responded well when asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch and held under steady urging. DOLCE SERA dropped back soon after the start then fell well off the pace, moved closer late on the backstretch, was urged along in the four to five path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and willingly earned the place. POSEIDON'S MIST angled in outside the three-quarter pole then was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the leader into upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. MAGIC EIGHT BALL was carried out near the seven-eighths pole, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, dropped back near the eleven-sixteenths pole then moved in, stalked outside from that juncture, raced in the two to three path on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the winner into upper stretch and tired. KAREN'S HONOR dropped back fast while angling in near the seven-eighths pole, was hard ridden late on the backstretch, moved from the two path to the five path on the turn, spun into upper stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response. BARONESS BOURBON ducked in at the start and was slow into stride, spotted the front a few lengths, moved closer late on the backstretch, raced inside to the two path on the turn, drifted out under a left-handed crop in upper stretch and failed to threaten. SHEZA BERNARDINI settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three to four path, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back while remaining on her inside lead in upper stretch and came up empty.

CATCHPHRASE coaxed from the gate, established the front soon after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under light coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch roused for the drive, went clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole, then got geared down inside the final sixteenth to the finish. MOONLIT WEEKEND got brushed at the start by DAT DARES RIGHT, who broke outwards, and in turn bumped SHE'S COOL, chased along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while along for the place honors. TOXIC GIRL broke out at the start, chased three then two wide under urging from midway on the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. SHE'S COOL got bumped at the start by MOONLIT WEEKEND due to pressure from DAT DARES RIGHT, chased three to four wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, went eight wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. DAT DARES RIGHT broke out at the start brushing MOONLIT WEEKEND who in turn bumped SHE'S COOL, chased two then three wide coming under encouragement near the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and tired. GREGORIAN SOLO chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths, cornered four wide at the head of the stretch, trailed.

AH CA IRA was hustled from the gate, disputed the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, dueled with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while well clear for the place. KHALI'S STORM showed speed and pressed the pace, vied in the two path while between horses on the turn, dropped back late on that bend and tired while clear for the show. SKY RUNNER moved up while settling under some restraint then was well placed behind the leaders, dropped back under urging at the seven-sixteenths pole, went around the turn in the two path, was driven into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed response. HEAVENS LEE broke out at the start, settled off the pace, moved out late on the backstretch, dropped from the three path to the two path while roused on the turn and came up empty. STAGED CONFLICT lost her footing at the start and was off a bit slow, moved out under urging at the rear in the early going, lagged at the back, dropped in near the five-eighths pole, rounded the turn in the two path, shifted out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and was no factor. DEAR JOHN was hustled from the gate, settled under some urging, came under stronger encouragement in the four path on the turn and had nothing left.
