PETROLO moved from the two path to the four path early on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was given his cue in the four path on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, remained on his inside lead while pulled in by the rider several times in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead while taking the advantage outside the eighth-pole, battled outside of the runner-up in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under good handling. A LISTER was hustled from the gate, dropped from the two path to the rail on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, vied inside to the two path on the far turn, was roused for more outside the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, lost the advantage outside the furlong marker, was switched to a left-handed crop and given one pop inside that marker, had the rider lose the crop outside the sixteenth-pole, fought on determinedly with the winner under a strong hand-ride to the finish and just missed but was clear for the place. LANDAUER broke outward then angled in early, dropped from the two path to the rail early on the first turn, settled under some urging, advanced closer late on the backstretch, was roused while moving from the two path to the four path on the far turn, shifted to the five path outside the quarter-pole, chased the top two in the stretch and earned the show. BOSS THREE O TWO raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside of the leader, made a bid late on the backstretch, vied in the three path while urged along on the far turn, dropped back some under a drive into upper stretch, chased the leaders in the drive and lacked the needed kick. BLAME IT ON DADDY moved from the three path to the two path midway through the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced closer late on the backstretch, was asked while inside to the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the crop, pursued the vanguard in the drive and also lacked the needed kick. OLLIE CAN DANCE was a bit reluctant to load while backed in the gate from the front, came away slow and spotted the front a few lengths, moved from the rail to the two path late on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, dropped from the three path to the rail early on the far turn, saved ground from that point into the stretch and was no factor.

SILO RIDGE coaxed from the gate, chased five the four wide coming under urging at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, came in slightly straightened away and brushed with ARI'S MAGIC, had that rival attempt to nudge his way out a furlong out when the leader drifted in front, denied the move and rallied to take command a sixteenth from home, then edged away to the finish to prevail. ENDURING SPIRIT got bumped and taken in hand at the start when ARI'S MAGIC recovered outwards from a bobble and took over his lane, ranged up to take command five and a half furlongs from home and cut the pace three wide down the backstretch and through the turn widening away with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch set down for the drive, dug in under a drive and came out a path a furlong out, got collared with a sixteenth to run and ran on to preserve the place honors. ARI'S MAGIC bobbed at the break recovering outwards and bumping ENDURING SPIRIT and forcing that rival to be taken in hand briefly, chased three then two wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths, swung three wide into upper stretch and was brushed straightened away, had the aforementioned foe drift out a path near the eighth pole and attempted to lean on SILO RIDGE to nudge that foe outwards and was denied the move, altered to the inside inside that station and kept on to procure the show honors clear of the rest. CAMM' DUKE chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging at the three-eighths, took the inside route into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. FACE THE FACTS grew fractious in the gate and broke open the stall door prior to the start, chased three then four wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, offered no response, then was vetted upon returning after the gallop out and was transported off the course via equine ambulance. CELTIC PRINCE coaxed from the start, chased four then three wide under a ride from midway on the turn, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, tired. There was a Jockey's Objection by the rider of ARI'S MAGIC alleging interference in the stretch against SILO RIDGE. After review, the objection was dismissed and the result was allowed to stand prior to the race being declared official.

ALTERNATE REALITY bumped solidly with a foe at the start, was rated early then well placed behind the leading group, shifted from the two path to the four path midway through the turn, moved to the five path while gaining late on that bend, rallied to the lead into upper stretch then moved in, battled outside of the runner-up into the final furlong then edged clear under strong urging. COSTA TERRA stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid with five furlongs to run, took the lead in the four path on the turn, dropped to the three path into upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner near the three-sixteenths pole then moved further in, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while clear for the place. TABEGUACHE brushed with a rival after the start, contested the pace on the inside of opponents, vied along the rail while roused on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened but held the show. MISTICAL CURLIN was hustled from the gate then brushed with a foe after the start, contested the pace on the outside then between foes starting near the five-eighths pole, was asked in the two path while still between foes on the turn, dropped back while crowded in upper stretch then moved out and tired. CENTAVO settled on the outside, was roused in the three to four path on the turn, dropped to the two path late on that bend, moved to the rail at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. LOST IN ROME bumped solidly with a rival at the start then dropped back, was guided out early then altered back in off of heels, moved up to race just off the pace, made a bid between horses with five furlongs to run, vied in the three path while still between foes under urging on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and also tired.

DESPO'S DREAM got steadied after the start when losing her lane but only lost two lengths of ground to the leader, chased four then three wide coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, then edged away to the finish kept to task. SHAMAN PRINCESS prompted the pace of ALLEY'S SONG three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in running on to secure the place honors. ALLEY'S SONG cut the pace along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got collared a furlong out, ran on to preserve the show honors. DANNEEL chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging midway on the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on under a drive to the finish, well clear of the rest. BIG HAZEL chased five then four wide under a ride from the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. EASTERN STAR stumbled badly at the start and conceded four to five lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn, went three to four wide into upper stretch and made no impact. SANTAGATA got bumped at the start by MY CARA MIA MINE, who broke outwards, chased along the inside, tipped out five wide coming under urging at the three-eighths, went seven wide into upper stretch and tired. MY CARA MIA MINE broke out at the start bumping SANTAGATA, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, went three wide into upper stretch and trailed.
