ROMAN GODDESS coaxed from the gate, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn getting placed to coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, swung six then five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a sixteenth from home, inched away in the late stages to the wire. MAD FOR MADDY dueled from the two path with LA GROTTE midway down the backstretch, tucked inside into the turn and was shaken off with seven-sixteenths to go and came under urging at the three-eighths, took the inside route into upper stretch, came again along the inside and ran on to secure the place honors. JERRY'S OUT coaxed from the gate, chased three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, went six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged clear to the finish kept to task. E Z BOURBON coaxed from the start, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then three then two wide through the turn coming under coaxing midway, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on to garner the place honors. JUST LICORICE broke inwards coaxed from the gate and brushed MILES AND MILES, chased five then four wide down the backstretch detached at the tail of the field, tucked inside through the turn, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. Following a saddle adjustment behind the gate, MILES AND the start by JUST LICORICE, cut the pace five then four wide down the backstretch before tucking three then two wide through the turn, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught a furlong out, weakened in the late stages. STEEL VENGEANCE veered in at the break, chased along the inside down the backstretch before heading four wide through the turn coming under urging at the three-eighths marker, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the end. LOU coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide down the backstretch before heading five wide through the turn under a ride from three furlongs out, swung six then five wide for home and tired.
