JACKIE THE JOKER went to the front, set the pace under pressure to her outside, vied along the rail on the turn, shook clear late on that bend, was asked turning into the stretch then came under a strong hand-ride, was put to a right-handed crop inside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed crop inside the sixteenth-pole and held under steady urging. COLLECT DATTTT broke out some but was very quickly corrected with a pull of the left rein, tracked the pace on the outside of the leader, was asked in the three path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the four path, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth, swapped back to her inside lead late and missed while able to get the place. R FUNNY BIZNESS settled at the rear, was roused in the two then three path on the turn, gained under a drive in the stretch and willingly earned the show. SHEZANARCTICQUEEN broke out and was off a step slow, moved up to race just off the pace on the outside, was roused in the four path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed kick. MAGGIE T was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, vied in the two path on the turn, dropped back late on that bend, moved out in upper stretch and tired. GOLDCREST settled just off the pace, saved ground under urging on the turn and came up empty.

ROMAN GODDESS coaxed from the gate, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn getting placed to coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, swung six then five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a sixteenth from home, inched away in the late stages to the wire. MAD FOR MADDY dueled from the two path with LA GROTTTE midway down the backstretch, tucked inside into the turn and was shaken off with seven-sixteenths to go and came under urging at the three-eighths, took the inside route into upper stretch, came again along the inside and ran on to secure the place honors. HARLAN'S BOND hustled from the gate, raced forwardly placed four wide coaxed along down the backstretch, advanced nine-sixteenths from home to vied briefly for the front before emerging to duel with LA GROTTTE with seven-sixteenths to go, knocked heads through the turn and continued three wide into upper stretch, dug in clinging to command until displaced a sixteenth from home, kept on to preserve the show honors. LA GROTTTE coaxed from the gate, led early on from the two path before being engaged in a duel by MAD FOR MADDY and then a pace dispute when joined by the aforementioned foe with nine-sixteenths to run, shook off that inner pace rival and dueled through the turn with HARLAN'S BOND coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. TROUBLED LUCK bobbled at the break, chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and weakened. FAST KIMMIE five then four wide in pursuit, got ridden along three furlongs out, swung four wide into upper stretch, tired.

FRANTIC followed the leader early then dropped back near the five-eighths pole, ranged up in the four path on the turn, made a bid coming to the quarter-pole, took the lead in upper stretch, shook clear under a solid hand-ride inside the furlong marker, extended the advantage into the final sixteenth then was put under lighter encouragement while much the best. PANDEMIC HERO bumped with a foe just after the start then quickly sped clear, opened up a sizable advantage, moved from the rail to the two path on th turn, had his lead diminish late on that bend, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch, fought with that foe into the final furlong and was outfinished while just able to get the place. DARK DEVIL was coaxed along in third position, raced between horses in the two path on the turn, moved closer late on that bend, spun into the stretch in the four path, chased the top two into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick then just missed the place while able to get the show. PARTY WITH SMARTY bumped with a foe just after the start, was urged along off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved closer late on that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive and also lacked the needed kick. BOBBY BOB raced between foes early, tossed his head when the winner dropped back and steadied nearing the five-eighths pole, went around the turn in the two then three path, moved closer late on that bend, came out to the five path into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TEARS IN RAIN was urged along on the outside, traveled around the turn in the five path and failed to respond.

LOU coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide down the backstretch before heading five wide through the turn urged along from midway, angled seven to eight wide into upper stretch, made no headway. BERNIE GOES BOOM coaxed from the gate, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then six wide through the turn under a ride from three furlongs out, swung six then five wide for home and tired.
