DERBYNESS broke out at the start and traded a bump with DYLAN'S RUBY, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, went seven wide into upper stretch, closed well outside and was just up on the wire to score. LIGHT THE WAY showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside, got set down angled four to five wide into upper stretch, edged clear to the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat and was nailed at the finish. DYLAN'S RUBY broke awkwardly inwards and traded a bump with DERBYNESS, chased four then three wide early on before tucking to the two path near the half mile pole, went to the inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. I SEE YOU LOOKIN lost his lane when J D FACTOR broke outwards and was taken in hand briefly conceding three lengths to the front, chased two to three wide under a ride from the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked. J D FACTOR broke open his stall door prior to the start, broke out at the start taking over the lane of I SEE YOU LOOKIN, chased inside briefly before tipping to the three path nudging HATCH to be four wide, tucked to the two path into the turn coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, swung three wide for home and weakened in the stretch. HATCH chased three wide early on until nudged to the four path by the aforementioned foe five furlongs out, came under coaxing tucked three wide at the three-eighths, angled five wide at the top of the stretch and tired.

PRINCE VALIANT was hustled to the front then showed the way, controlled the action while inside on the turn, responded well when asked near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch and extended the advantage under steady urging to prove much the best. SOONTOBEKING tracked the pace down the backstretch, chased in the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch under the crop, pursued the winner in the drive and finished with good courage while second best. NATIONAL IDENTITY settled just off the pace on the inside, drafted behind the leader while under restraint along the rail on the turn, was asked turning into upper stretch and came up empty while clearly best of the rest. HUGGY raced between foes early then settled at the rear, was urged along late on the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the two path, turned into upper stretch under a drive and had nothing left. IN THE CHASE was last away then moved up on the outside to race just off the pace, chased in the three path on the turn, dropped back late on that bend and faltered.

PIRATE hustled from the gate, established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside through the first turn before taking to the inside down the backstretch, remained along the rail through the far turn patiently handled until given a notch to work with near the five-sixteenths, came under very light coaxing and began to slip away spinning three wide into upper stretch, got roused straightened away and went clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole, saw some of that margin cut into while kept to task well clear to the wire. CHILENO coaxed from the start, chased along the inside coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick while drifting out to look MALARCHUK in the eye to prevail in the battle for the place homing. MALARCHUK four wide through the first turn, chased three wide coming under encouragement at the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid while well clear of the rest for the show honors. MIKEALICIOUS brushed the near side stall at the start, chased along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. FRIZZANTE broke in a step at the start, raced three wide through the first turn and then four wide down the backstretch and through the far turn coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled six wide into upper stretch, tired in the drive. HOKU just off the inside through the first turn, was taken under a firm hold off heels between foes with six and a half furlongs to run when the field bunched up into the backstretch, chased two to three wide under a ride from the three-eighths pole, tipped five wide into upper stretch and tired. GLINT broke out a step at the start, raced three wide through the first turn, chased just off the inside coming under encouragement midway on the far turn, cornered four wide into upper stretch and faltered through to the finish.

STORM CHANGER bumped with a rival at the start, moved in while settling off the pace, angled from the rail to the six path on the turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed well to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with two rivals late and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. PRINCESS MISCHIEF had her saddle adjusted behind the gate, was last away then dropped back while steadying in tight quarters, settled at the rear, raced inside to the three path under urging on the turn, swung out to the seven path into the stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong, closed fast to make a bid outside of two foes late and just missed while narrowly able to get the place. DISCO STAR was urged along off the pace, dropped from the three path to the rail on the turn, rallied while cutting the corner at the quarter-pole, took the lead in upper stretch, began to drift out while put to a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, continued to drift out while switched to a left-handed crop in the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth then was headed, fought on well to the finish and just missed while clear for the show. DECREE AND DECLARE broke in and bumped with a rival, was coaxed along off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, chased into the final furlong, moved in some around the sixteenth-pole and weakened. HOWLING WIND was hustled to the front then showed the way, vied inside of a rival while asked in the two path on the turn, lost the advantage under a drive in upper stretch and tired then was reported to have bled. BAM'S BLISS KISS moved out then tracked the pace, made a bid near the

nine-sixteenths pole, vied in the three path on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and also weakened. ROYAL EVENT was urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the three to four path and failed to threaten. FOREVER TO GO was urged along on the outside, went around most of the turn in the four path then shifted to the five path, dropped back into upper stretch then drifted in, drifted out inside the furlong marker and came up empty.
