LOOKING FOR GINNY dropped back quickly after the start then was urged along at the rear, moved from the three path to the two path early on the turn, remained in the two path under a strong hand-ride through that bend, shifted out while gaining in upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead just inside the furlong marker, fought outside of the runner-up to the finish and prevailed under strong urging. KYLE'S MOM moved in near the three-quarter pole then tracked the pace, shifted outside of the leader before the five-eighths pole, gained leaving the backstretch, took the lead in the three to four path on the turn, was put to the crop in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner just inside the furlong marker, fought with that foe to the finish and missed while clear for the place. LUMENIQUE veered out at the start, settled off the pace, was roused in the four to five path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive then was carried out and lacked the needed response but was clear for the show. EXOTIC CAT was bumped at the start then taken up some with a tug of the left rein, raced off the pace under urging, gained leaving the backstretch, made a bid along the rail inside the seven-sixteenths pole, vied inside on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened. AERIALIST broke out and bumped with a rival, bore out while going clear, dropped in outside the five-eighths pole, shortened stride late on the backstretch, gave up the lead early on the turn, dropped back in the two then three path on that bend and stopped then was eased but walked off.

DONOR ADVISED got away to a stumbling start, showed the way in hand along the inside coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in dueling through the stretch to the finish and gamely prevailed at the end. SHIRL'S DELIGHT three wide through the first turn, prompted the pace of the aforementioned foe from the two path, got set down spinning three to four wide into upper stretch, dug in dueling through the length of the stretch and fought on to the finish but was ultimately bested at the end. STAND THE RAIN four then three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, kept on through to the finish. LUCKFORYOU broke out at the start brushing the off side stall and then bumping THAT'S FUNNY, chased three then two wide, came under coaxing at the three-eighths along the inside, angled four wide into upper stretch and offered no rally. EASILY SIDETRACKED stumbled at the start, chased three wide until tucked inside into the turn, came under urging at the three-eighths, angled five wide for home and made no impact. THAT'S FUNNY got bumped at the start by LUCKFORYOU, who broke outwards, chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and tired.

HOULTON settled comfortably just off the pace, drafted behind horses while in the two to three path on the turn, shifted to the four path while roused outside the quarter-pole, chased outside under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, gained into the final sixteenth and got up under good handling to prevail. INCANTATION settled on the outside, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the four path on the turn, gained to make a bid outside of three foes at the five-sixteenths pole, took the lead while dropping to the three path into upper stretch, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while well clear for the place. BRODERICK bumped with a rival at the start then dropped back, settled at the rear, moved closer outside the half-mile pole, gained to make a bid inside of the leaders leaving the backstretch, took a short lead while inside midway through the turn, lost the advantage into upper stretch then dropped back and weakened. SORORITY PRANK bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside of a foe, drifted out outside the five-eighths pole then moved back in later on the backstretch, vied in the two path while between horses on the turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. BREWING disputed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path while asked on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and capitulated.

KING OF THE CASTLE coaxed from the gate, led early on before being engaged in a duel while just off the inside by BIG EGO to his outside with nine-sixteenths to run, tucked inside through the turn and knocked heads coming under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch now under threat from a pair, shook off his main pace rival confronted by the runner up at the three-sixteenths, dug in to rebuff that challenge, then edged clear to the finish to prevail. MAGNI chased two then three wide coming under urging at the seven-sixteenths, advanced to offer up a bid swinging five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive challenging the leader through to inside the eighth pole, then got repelled and shaken off in the late stages. ARK ROYAL broke out at the start and was corrected, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and through the turn coming under urging at the three-eighths marker, tipped seven then six wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the show honors. GORZO struck the near side stall at the start, chased four wide under a long drive from the half mile pole, went eight wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid to improve position to the finish. UNCLE BARRIE chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path and got placed to coaxing at the half mile pole, spun

two to three wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. BIG EGO coaxed from the gate, dueled three then two wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and tired. BREAK THE FALL coaxed from the start, chased four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, continued four wide into upper stretch, tired. VESUVIO bobbed at the break, chased five paths off the inside until tucked to the inside with nine-sixteenths to run, got coaxed along half a mile from home and continued in the inside route through the turn and into upper stretch and trailed.
