GOLDCREST broke out at the start and was corrected, chased along the inside patiently handled until set down angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge inside the final furlong and was up in the last jumps over a pair to prevail. LIKA ROLLING STONE stumbled at the start and came under hustling to show the way in hand just off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got headed for command a furlong out, fought on to the finish taking back narrow command a sixteenth from home, then got caught in the final strides. SHEZANARCTICQUEEN chased five then four wide down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the turn, advanced on the front coming under urging nearing the quarter pole, swung five then four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive taking narrow command a furlong out, got displaced from the front with a sixteenth to go and battled on between foes to the end. EVERLYS GIRL forwardly placed from the start, prompted the leader from the outside four then three wide down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the turn and came under encouragement three furlongs out, swung three wide into upper stretch between rivals, then weakened through to the finish.

SHARED SUCCESS came away in good order then went to the front, showed the way on the inside of rivals while off the inside, vied in the two path for most of the turn while asked then dropped to the rail, was put to a drive into upper stretch, came under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, fought inside of the runner-up to the finish and prevailed under strong urging. SENEGAL was hustled from the gate, moved out near the seven-eighths pole, gained to press the pace between horses then on the outside of the leader, vied in the three path for most of the turn while asked then dropped to the two path, turned into the stretch under a right-handed crop, was switched to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker then drifted out some, fought on outside the winner under a strong hand-ride into the final sixteenth, was given one pop of a right-handed crop late and missed while far clear for the place. CUMBERLAND BLUES leaned out at the start and was off a step slow, raced on the outside under urging, moved in near the nine-sixteenths pole, was urged along in the two path early on the turn, dropped to the rail briefly near the three-eighths pole then moved back to the two path, shifted to the three path while dropping back outside the quarter-pole and tired while clear for the show. LANDAUER was ridden along at the rear, shifted from the rail to the two path on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. A LISTER pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back under urging late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three then four path while falling to the rear, spun into the stretch in the five path, drifted out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and faltered.

GONE BOY broke in at the start trading a bump with LIMITS OF POWER, showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, shook away and spun just off the inside into upper stretch, forged clear under a drive through the stretch to the finish kept to task. BELMONT UNION chased three wide down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn ridden along from the three-eighths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while along clear of the rest for the place honors. HER SUGAR BABY coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide in closest aim of the leader coming under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled five then four wide into upper stretch, tired. PRAIRIE DUNES coaxed from the start, chased along the inside under encouragement with seven-sixteenths to run, angled three wide into upper stretch, tired. NILRUC six paths off the inside in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked four wide into the turn under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, went eight wide at the head of the stretch, tired in the drive. LIMITS OF POWER broke out at the start trading a bump with GONE BOY, chased along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and made no impact. MANO E MANO coaxed from the start, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn pushed along from the three-eighths pole, went three wide at the top of the stretch and faltered through to the finish.

DILLINGER chased five wide coming under encouragement at the three-eighths marker, swung five then four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in under threat from flanking rivals and was caught with seventy yards to the finish, ran on to best a foe on the wire for the place honors. FUNNY JOKE broke in at the start brushing CONNIVING, dueled from the two path with RETURN THE RING to his outside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared a furlong out, ran on clear of the rest to secure the show honors.
