DOOMED raced in the three path on the first turn, settled comfortably on the outside, was roused in the three path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the four path, rallied while remaining on his inside lead, closed well to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole and got up to narrowly prevail under strong urging. RAGAZZO D'ORO rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved in the back half of the field, raced in the three path while roused on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the five path, rallied on the outside to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, battled with multiple opponents to the finish and just missed while narrowly able to get the place. ROMEO VOID raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while asked in the three path on the far turn, fought on well with multiple rivals in the stretch and just missed while narrowly able to get the show. FRESH START was hustled from the gate, angled in while going to the front, showed the way on the inside, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage outside the quarter-pole, battled on well to the finish and just missed while being denied a spot in the trifecta. MAKEYOURMOMENT bumped with a rival at the start, moved out before reaching the wire for the first time, raced in the two path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, was asked in the two path while between foes on the far turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, led under a drive to the sixteenth-pole then was headed, fought on to the finish and just missed while denied a spot in the superfecta. SOLOMINI'S LEGACY bumped with a foe early, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused in the three path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed kick. DANCINGINTHEPARK was well placed just off the pace on the inside, dropped back with three furlongs to run, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CADA DIA MEJOR was fractious in the gate, established a forward position early, was well placed in the two path, came under urging on the far turn, chased under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. YO BRO bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. DEAD AIM rounded the first turn in the two path, was urged along near the back, saved ground on the far turn, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. PISTOL HIP SAM saved ground on the first turn, moved out at the rear early on the backstretch, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, traveled around most of the far turn in the four path then dropped to the two path and was no factor. DANZIGER bumped with a rival early, moved out before the wire for the first time, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the three path on the far turn and failed to respond.
