AWESOME ROBERTA showed speed then chased the pace, dropped back in crowded quarters near the half-mile pole, moved from the three path to the four path on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive, pursued the leader while remaining on her inside lead, gained into the final sixteenth and got up under strong urging to prevail. ADA MAY bumped with foes on both sides at the start, moved out near the five-eighths pole then advanced on the outside, made a bid near the nine-sixteenths pole, vied in the four then three path on the turn, took the lead with three furlongs to run, dropped to the two path while shaking clear late on the bend, was set down after turning into the stretch, passed the furlong marker under a right-handed crop, drifted out outside the sixteenth-pole and was overtaken while just able to get the place. JUST WORDS broke in and bumped with a foe, showed speed then contested the pace on the outside, vied in the two path while between horses on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch, chased while remaining on her inside lead until outside the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead, kept on well in the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth then moved in, made a bid late but was outfinished then just missed the place while able to get the show. CAROL SAID NO was hustled from the gate, raced just off the pace under some urging, moved from the rail to the two path very early on the turn, continued in the two path around most of the bend, shifted to the three path outside the quarter-pole, dropped back some while driven into the stretch in the five path, kept on in the final furlong and finished willingly. POWER DRIVER broke out at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, fell further off the pace leaving the backstretch, rounded the turn in the two path and lacked the needed response. YAYI NIKOLLE broke out and bumped with a foe, was taken in hand early then settled at the rear, moved in around the nine-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. LIGHT THOUGHTS moved up outside the five-eighths pole to contest the pace on the inside of an opponent, vied along the rail under urging on the turn, dropped back nearing the quarter-pole and faded.

DIALBOLICO chased four then three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the three-sixteenths and inched away under a drive kept to task. HENRY'S HOPE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until placed to light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, came under a right handed crop and shied inwards to the rail three-sixteenths from home getting corrected at that station when displaced from command, tipped out a furlong out to engage the aforementioned foe from the outside through the final furlong and ran on willingly to the finish well clear of the rest and along second best. BRACA chased along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, improved position to the finish. DAW SAMAA hustled from the start, chased three then two wide under encouragement from the seven-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, weakened. CHANGE YOUR NAME bobbled at the break, chased three then two wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled out seven wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the drive.

SHE'S WICKED SMART disputed the pace on the inside of rivals while off the rail, vied in the two path while inside of a rival for most of the turn, dropped to the rail late on that bend, drifted out when put to a left-handed crop in upper stretch, continued to drift out into the final furlong, dueled with the runner-up to the finish and gamely prevailed. DREAM ON CARA dropped back after the start, settled at the rear under some urging, was roused while in the three path on the turn, moved to the four path late on that bend, rallied in the five path into upper stretch, closed well to make a bid at the furlong marker, took a short lead near the sixteenth-pole, dueled with the winner while bobbing heads to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. DANNEEL showed speed then disputed the pace, vied in the three path while outside of the winner for most of the turn then dropped to the two path, was carried out some in upper stretch, moved in passing the furlong marker and weakened while clear for the show. EASTERN STAR was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back some late on the backstretch, chased in the four path for most of the turn then dropped to the three path, was carried out some in upper stretch, moved in just inside the furlong marker and tired. ALLEY'S SONG was hustled from the gate, moved in outside the five-eighths pole then was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, made a bid along the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back while skimming the rail into upper stretch, remained on her inside lead in the drive and came up empty.

INTENTIOUS settled towards the rear, saved ground on the turn, was roused nearing the quarter-pole then asked for her best in upper stretch, moved out in the final furlong and also improved position but just missed the show. MISS BOURBON broke out then dropped back

quickly, raced towards the rear, went around most of the turn in the four path then shifted to the five path, turned into the stretch in the six path then moved further out and also improved but missed the superfecta. HONORABLE BECKY was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, settled at the rear, moved from the rail to the three path under urging on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path then angled to the far outside and failed to threaten. PEONY was away alertly, settled off the pace, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, swung out to the four path into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SINEAD bobbed at the start, settled on the outside, was roused in the four path on the turn, dropped back while taken in hand near the quarter-pole, moved to the three path into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. MULKEY settled off the pace, saved ground under urging while moving closer on the turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and came up empty. KAATERSKILL bumped with a rival at the start while also brushing with another foe, settled off the pace, raced in the three path for most of the turn then dropped to the two path, was roused near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. MISS AMERICAN PIE was urged along off the pace, went around most of the turn in the three path then moved to the four path and also failed to respond. AUNT YOLA bumped with a rival at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn and capitulated.

GALLANT GRETA settled tracking the pace along the inside in aim of the top pair, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go and angled out four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied to collar the front just outside the eighth pole, then edged clear to the finish. ON A SUMMER DAY coaxed from the gate, pulled early on the bit into the first turn when under restraint down along the rail, settled down the backstretch in mid pack and was patiently handled until set down angled four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive running on willingly to secure the place honors while unable to threaten the winner. HEAVENLY GIRL coaxed from the gate, led early on into the first turn along the inside before being displaced from command by HIGH END into the backstretch, settled tracking that rival in closest aim two to three wide down the backstretch before committing to the two path through the far turn, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go and spun two to three wide into upper stretch heads apart for command, got displaced in tandem with her main rival just outside the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors. HIGH END raced forwardly placed just off the inside into and through the far turn taking over the front just inside six furlongs to run, crossed to the inside into the backstretch when safely clear and showed the way in hand, remained patiently handled as the aforementioned foe intensified the pressure through the far turn getting on near even terms when roused taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was overhauled in concert with HEAVENLY GIRL just outside the eighth pole, weakened through to the finish. LOVEUMISSUMEANIT broke out at the start, raced three wide through the first turn before chasing just off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside through the far turn and came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled out six wide at the head of the stretch and passed tired rivals through to the wire. BLUE FOR YOU got bumped at the start by TWIRLY, who broke outwards, chased just off the inside coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, angled five wide at the top of the lane and weakened in the stretch. PRACTICAL ROMANCE just off the inside through the first turn, settled four wide in pursuit from mid pack down the backstretch, continued four wide through the far turn and got let out spinning two to three wide for home, then weakened in the drive. CASTLEDELL broke a half a beat slow and lost her lane to BLUE FOR YOU due to pressure from TWIRLY, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened. ARGENTIERA chased three wide through to the quarter pole coming under urging from three furlongs out, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the lane. TWIRLY broke out at the start bumping BLUE FOR YOU, chased along the inside patiently handled until set down angled four wide at the top of the stretch, made no impact. ONE MORE DANCE coaxed from the gate, raced four then three wide through the first turn, chased four to five wide down the backstretch before heading five wide through the far turn under light coaxing from the three-eighths marker, tipped six wide into upper stretch and tired. TIZN'T ANYMORE a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased three wide thereafter coming under encouragement near the five-sixteenths, went seven wide at the head of the lane and was unable to make an impact.
