CARESS got brushed at the start by WILL BE FAMOUS, who broke outwards a step, dueled three then two wide with MAJESTIC RETURN to her inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, dug in under a drive and gamely inched away in the late stages to prevail. WILL BE FAMOUS broke out a step at the start brushing CARESS, chased four then three wide under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. MAJESTIC RETURN hustled from the start, dueled from the two path with CARESS to her outside, tucked inside into the turn and came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, fought on through to the finish keeping on to preserve the show honors on the wire. PROUD FOOT coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under encouragement from three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. LA BANQUERA stumbled at the start pecking the ground and conceded three lengths to the front before settling into stride briefly along the inside, tipped out to chase four paths off the inside down the backstretch and continued four wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered no response.

NAIVE MELODY coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way in hand three then two wide under some pressure early on, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths under threat from a pair of rivals, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to prevail. VEKINDA broke in at the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under a ride at the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while offering up a mild kick to secure the place honors in the final jumps to the wire. THREE B'S broke out at the start, chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn urged along from the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. KENNY BE got bumped at the start by GIVEMEMYTHEMUSIC, who broke outwards, chased just off the inside and then along the inside patiently handled until set down cornering just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong. SCHEDULING DUDE broke out at the start, prompted the pace from the outside five then three wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, went three wide at the head of the stretch and weakened in the final eighth. GIVEMEMYTHEMUSIC broke out at the start, chased four wide down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn, came under encouragement midway on the turn, tipped four wide into upper stretch and tired.

EMPTY TOMB showed speed on the inside of an opponent then set the pace under pressure, moved to a solo lead leaving the backstretch, vied inside on the turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage briefly in upper stretch but came back quickly to regain the lead, battled inside of the runner-up until near the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under steady urging. CATCH THE SMOKE was hustled from the gate, established a good position just off the pace under urging, chased while moving from the rail to the two path on the turn, made a bid on the outside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, took a short and brief lead in upper stretch then lost the advantage back to the winner, battled with that foe until near the sixteenth-pole then was outfinished while well clear for the place. VALENZAN DAY was hustled from the gate, angled out nearing the seven-eighths pole, settled on the outside, was roused in the three then four path on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. CO CONSPIRATOR was hustled from the gate, showed speed then pressed the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased in the two to three path on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and tired. ICE ROAD was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, dropped well behind under urging, rounded the turn in the two path, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. PRINCE OF JOY was forced out early, settled on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, dropped back in the four then five path on the turn and retreated.

ALAN TURING went around the first turn in the four then five path, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid outside the half-mile pole, took the lead in the two path early on the turn, shook clear outside the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under a drive into the final furlong and maintained a safe advantage under steady urging. COACH CASE dropped from the two path to the rail early on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while inside to the two path on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, brushed with a rival outside the furlong marker and finished with good energy to safely secure the place. VITALIZE bumped with a rival just after the start, was taken under a strong hold early, bumped with that same foe before the first turn, raced in the

four path on that bend, tracked the pace on the outside, was given his cue in the three path on the far turn, chased the winner under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but held the show. HELLO NEWMAN brushed with a foe after the start then angled in, raced between foes under restraint into the first turn, rounded that bend in the two path, settled off the pace, was roused while in the three path on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, brushed with an opponent outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. FREE DANCE bumped with a rival just after the start, bumped with that same foe before the first turn, went around that bend in the three path, settled on the outside, was asked in the two to three path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. KISMEHOLDMETHRLME went around the opening bend in the three path, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging in the two path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and also lacked the needed response. G FIVE was hustled from the gate then well placed just off the pace on the inside, saved ground while asked on the far turn and came up empty. ATATURK broke a step slow, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, moved from the two path to the four path on the far turn, dropped inward in upper stretch and failed to threaten. POWERED BY COAL broke out but was quickly corrected by the rider, moved in while going to the front, traveled around the first turn in the two path, showed the way down the backstretch, lost the lead while inside early on the far turn and tired. HOME INVASION bumped hard with a rival just after the start, became very rank along the rail early and was taken up, saved ground towards the back of the field and was no factor. COCO SUN bumped hard with a rival just after the start, moved from the three path to the four path early on the first turn, settled near the back, went around the far turn in the four path, drifted inward in upper stretch and showed little. TIZTIMONIAL brushed with an opponent just after the start, moved in entering the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, settled towards the back, dropped in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and also was no factor.
