ADDIE bumped with a rival at the start, raced well back on the outside, moved in leaving the backstretch, rounded most of the turn in the three path then moved to the two path, dropped to the rail in upper stretch and improved position to just get the show. THREE NINES FINE angled in while showing speed, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the three then two path on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive in the three path into upper stretch, remained on her inside lead until the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead and tired then just missed the trifecta. EMBRACEABLE GAL chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths, advanced on the front through the latter portion of the turn taking over command swinging four to five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and had his main danger come outwards a furlong out, came in slightly nearing the sixteenth pole and traded a bump with that rival, then dug in gamely to hold sway rebuffing the challenger to the finish. CHASING DAYLIGHT coaxed from the start, chased four paths off the inside in closest aim of the leader down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the turn and applied some pressure to the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths when the aforementioned foe arrived on the scene to the outside, held narrow command inside that station and swung three to four wide into upper stretch and was displaced straightened away, dug in under a left handed crop coming out a path a furlong out, came out slightly once more as EMBRACEABLE GAL came in slightly and traded a bump nearing the sixteenth pole, ran on to the finish but was ultimately repelled to the end. MITOLE'S GIRL broke in at the start, chased three then two wide coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. SPLASHY cut the pace just off the inside and then along the inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole when displaced narrowly from command, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened. CAROL T chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn coaxed along from the three-eighths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch and weakened. TOP OF THE TABLE got bumped at the start by LADY ARWEN, chased along the inside under urging from three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, tired. LADY ARWEN broke in at the start bumping TOP OF THE TABLE, chased along the inside and then just off the inside urged along from midway on the turn, tipped out four wide into upper stretch and trailed. There was a Jockey's Objection by the rider of CHASING DAYLIGHT alleging interference against EMBRACEABLE GAL in the stretch. TOSCANO four then three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, drew clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages. OMEY ISLAND established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside at that station and angled out three to four wide at the three-sixteenths to look his main danger in the eye, got collared nearing the eighth pole, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to safely preserve the place honors. BRIGADE COMMANDER chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch and kept on to the finish. SCAT TU TAP coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and improved position to the finish.

KING MOONRACER chased three then two wide urged along from the five-sixteenths, angled out six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. NEON BORDEAUX got away last when off to an awkward beginning, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, went eight wide into upper stretch, offered no rally. BECAUSE THE NIGHT chased along the inside until tipped out placed to urging with seven-sixteenths to go, went four wide through the remainder of the turn and then five to six wide into upper stretch and offered no response. BRODERICK chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch and tired. OUTTAWATERBURY four then three wide in pursuit, got coaxed along at the seven-sixteenths, went nine wide at the top of the stretch, tired.
